Schepflins advance

BOWLING GREEN — Casey and Dena Schepflin advanced to today's quarterfinal round in the rain-delayed Division I high school girls district tennis tournament Friday.

The Schepflins, Fremont Ross's undefeated first-court doubles team, defeated Elizabeth McNicoll and Emily Wenger of Elida in their first match 6-1, 6-4.

In the quarterfinals, the Ross duo face Becky Swartz and Dorey Ingham of Toledo Bowsher.

In other matches, Ross singles player Dawn Zerman defeated Allison Noe of Toledo Notre Dame 6-4, 6-0 in her first match but was ousted from the tournament by Jean Lowry of Perrysburg in the second round, losing 7-5, 6-4.

The top three singles and doubles finishers advance to the state tournament next weekend in Columbus.

Matches were scheduled to begin at 9 a.m. Friday but were pushed back to 2:30 p.m. by rain.

Schepflins fall

Fremont Ross freshmen Casey Schepflin and Dena Schepflin lost to Toledo Bowsher's Becky Swartz and Corey Ingham 3-6, 7-6 (7-5), 6-3 Saturday at the Division I district tennis tournament at Bowling Green State University's Keefe Courts.

It was the Ross pair's first loss this season after 26 wins.

The match lasted 3½ hours.

"The girls did exceptionally well," Ross coach Sue Badertscher said. "For freshmen to get this far is something. We're not complaining on this end."
