Ross's O'Connor advances in 100 freestyle

BOWLING GREEN — Oak Harbor swim coach Bob Van Horn said he was a little edgy heading into the Northwest District Swimming and Diving Championships Thursday through Saturday at Bowling Green State University.

"I was a little nervous about how we might perform," Van Horn said. "We didn't have the (Oak Harbor) pool through the summer summertime until October (because of construction)."

"Under the circumstances, we swam extremely well this weekend. We did a great job."

The Rockets' girls team definitely left its mark during the district meet, setting numerous school records and finishing third with 237 points. Napoleon won the girls' meet with 308 points, while Sylvania Northview had 286. Fremont Ross girls placed fifth.

Ross's Molly O'Connor placed second in the 100-yard freestyle, as she finished in 52.92. On Friday O'Connor won the 50 freestyle and will compete in both events at the state level Friday and Saturday in Canton.

The Ross boys 200 freestyle relay team also qualified for state, finishing fourth and setting a new school record in 1:30.24.

"We had swam awesome,"

Ross coach Phil Moran said, noting that sophomore Brett Spicer dropped another 10 seconds off his 500-yard freestyle time.

On Saturday, Oak Harbor won two events and took second in one other, the 200 freestyle relay.

The 200 free relay team of Lindsay Lange, Amy Tabbert, Melissa Jenkins and Kelly Van Horn took second in 1 minute, 40.24 seconds a new school record.

Kelly Van Horn, a freshman, also won the backstroke in 59.97, a new school record, and sophomore Lindsay Lange won the breaststroke in 1:06.02.

The top two placers in each

event automatically qualified to compete the state meet.

"We'll go down to Canton and try to duplicate this performance and go a little faster," Bob Van Horn said. "I think we've got a little left. We're happy to be going down to Canton."

The Rockets scored 45 points in the backstroke alone. Junior Amy Tabbert was sixth and sophomore Andrea Lajti took seventh to complement Kelly Van Horn's winning finish.

Oak Harbor's boys team, with just 11 competitors on its roster, finished a respectable sixth in the team standings, with 130 points.

Toledo St. Francis DeSales

won the meet with 471 points followed by Northview with 234. Port Clinton had one point to tie Van Wert and Lima Central Catholic for 32nd place.

The top three individuals in the boys' events advanced to the state meet.

Oak Harbor senior Andy Jenkins earned an automatic bid by placing third in the 100 free (47.27). He also swam on the fifth-place 200 free relay team and on the sixth-place 400 free relay.

The 200 free relay team of Cory Barrett, Jenkins, Nick Lange and Nick Hillman led
