

Ross Team Fades

Mansfield Buckeye King In Annual Golf Tourney

MANSFIELD — Ross high school golfers faded badly in the second round, slipping from one point off the lead to last place in the Buckeye Conference golf championships here Monday. Ross had 159 strokes at the nine-hole turn, only one stroke behind eventual champion Mansfield.

The second nine the Little Giants ballooned to 28 strokes worse, 189, and 18-hole total of 346. Elyria, last at the turn, picked up 24 shots on Ross to slip into fifth place. Mansfield added a 157 to its first round 158 for the championship. Order of finish after Mansfield was Sandusky, 325; Findlay, 329; Marion, 337; Elyria, 342, and Ross, 346.

Despite finishing last Ross was the only team in the tourna-

ment to have three men with sub-40 rounds on one nine. Little Giant John Decker played consistent rounds in placing third in the bid for medalist honors. Decker put together rounds of 38-40 for 78. Medalist was Find-

lay's Steve Fife, 35-39-74, and second low was Tim Meehan, Mansfield, 77.

Playing for Ross are Decker; John Waggoner, 39-49-88; John Hepner, 44-53-97, and Terry Dailey, 38-45-83.
