

## From Staff Reports

Harding's baseball and softball squads both won sectional championships on Tuesday.

The Presidents' baseball team scored four runs each in the fourth and fifth innings and posted a 9-3 victory over Fremont Ross in Division I sectional final action at Mansfield Madison.

The Presidents (11-8) trailed the Little Giants (14-6) 1-0 heading into the bottom of the fourth inning.

Justin Knapp, Brooks Lowe and C.J. Westler each drove in two runs over the fourth and fifth innings while Tommy Conley blasted a solo home run in the sixth.

Lowe singled twice and doubled and Westler added three singles. Jerrod Slater, Conley, Knapp and Jared Haas each singled.

Scott Drollinger started and pitched into the seventh inning, relieved by Lowe with two outs and runners on first and second. Lowe had a game-ending strikeout. Drollinger allowed eight hits, struck out six and walked three. All three Fremont Ross runs were unearned as Harding committed three errors.

Harding plays host to Lima Senior today in Greater Buckeye Conference action and travels to Sandusky on Friday.

The Presidents return to the tournament trail on Monday, returning to Mansfield Madison to play the host Rams in a district semifinal.
