Ross Harriers Drop Opener

Ross high's cross country team dropped its first meet of the season Thursday, bowing to Toledo Macomber, 34-21.

Little Giant Don Yohe and Harold Daniels of the Toledo squad put on a stirring stretch duel at the end of the two-mile race at the county fair-grounds.

The two came into the stretch run almost in a dead heat but Daniels had a little more kick left and edged Yohe by a tenth of a second. Daniels was clocked in 10:38 and Yohe in 10:39. Yohe holds the course record of 10:37, set last year.

Following the two leaders across the line were Ralph Wood (M), Tom Harrax (M), Bob Mitchell (R), Don Jones (M), Willis Taffen (M), Tim Thomas (R), Danny Ross (R), and Hugh Pawsey (R).

Tuesday Coach Ron Brant's runners vie in a triangular meet with Amherst, state champs of two years ago, and unbeaten Clyde, which won its first two meets of the year.

Drop 2 Meets

Angelo Pecora set a new course record in leading Amherst to a 19-40 cross country verdict over Ross high's harriers Tuesday while Clyde captured the first four places to dump the Little Giant runners in the other dual meet, 18-40.

Coach Ron Brant's runners ran with both schools at the same time but the races were run as dual competition against Ross with the low times for each school counting separately.

Pecora toured the county fair-grounds course in 10:13, shattering the old record set by Jim Stimpert of Ashland in 1962 by one second.

Trailing him were two other Comets, Gary Pete and Russ Kulaga, Don Yohe got in for fourth in 10:42 while Tim Thomas trailed him by four seconds.

Clyde won the first four spots with Smart (10:33), Ramirez (10:35), Robert Carter and Rogshe goes after her third season Yohe and Thomas.

The next meet is October 8 against Ashland here.

Ashland got the next three places with Gregg Bell, Jerry Miller and Carl Uber coming across ahead of Bill Auxter, Dennis Brindly and Bob Grayson. Hugh Pawsey of Ross was 12th and Roy Crayton 14th.
