BCC tournament

At Rising Park, Findlay won the tournament with 120 points, followed by Newark (84), Lancaster (80), Ross (48) and Zanesville (28).

Ross' second doubles team of Whitney Shanahan and Ann Darr, both freshmen, took second overall. The two reached the finals, where they lost to Findlay's Kelly Drummond and Carrie Hahn 6-4, 6-3.

"For freshmen, that was excellent," Little Giants Coach Sue Badertscher said. "The two girls they played were both seniors. I expected them to take first.

"I'm not disappointed in the team overall," the coach said. "We lost in four tiebreakers. We played real well and didn't get some breaks. Had they gone our way, we could have been third instead of fourth."

Ross junior Amy Young took third in singles. She was third last year.

Young beat Lori Crow of Zanesville 8-2 in the consolation semis and came back to win the finals 8-6 over Newark's Debbie Prusaczyk.

Senior Dian Schepflin, Badertscher said, "played better than I've ever seen her play. She was outstanding. She almost took the top seed (Tricia Whitefield beat her 6-4, 0-6, 6-3 in the semifinals and went on to win the tournament).
