

Findlay wins BC golf again

MARION — The Findlay Trojans had no problem winning their ninth consecutive Buckeye Conference golf crown Monday.

The Trojans, winners of 54 consecutive dual and triangular matches, totaled 311 strokes to easily outdistance runnerup Marion Harding by 21 shots to capture the crown at the Marion Country Club.

The champions were led by Jim Wilkins and Bill Lundeen, both of whom shot 5-over-par 75s. Wilkins beat his teammate in a sudden-death playoff for medalist honors.

Ross scored 361 points to finish fourth behind third-place Sandusky (342) and ahead of fifth-place Elyria (382).

Matt Miller was low for Ross with an 85. Other Little Giant scores were Brian Dierksheide 87, Mark Mielse 90, Troy Schepflin 101, and Todd Crawshaw 99.
