



Little Giants Grind Out Opening Day Win at Oak Harbor

The Fremont Ross Little Giants opened their season in gritty fashion, earning a hard-fought 6-5 victory on the road against Oak Harbor.

Leading the way was ace pitcher Cam Joseph, who delivered a dominant performance on the mound. Joseph struck out 11 batters while allowing just one hit and three walks over four and two-thirds innings, setting the tone early for the Little Giants.

Offensively, Fremont Ross found contributions up and down the lineup. Cade Reineck, Parker Jackson, Carson Burkett, and Myles Carroll each recorded a hit, while JT Myers, Reineck, Burkett, and Carroll all drove in a run. Patience at the plate also paid off, as Dylan McDonald and Breylen Garza each drew two walks.

On the basepaths, Reineck and Garza created pressure with aggressive running, each swiping two bases to keep the Rockets on edge.

After Joseph's strong outing, Carroll came in to close things out and impressed in his first varsity opportunity, helping secure the narrow win.

Following the game, head coach Derek Thiessen praised his team's toughness in less-than-ideal conditions.

"I'm proud of the boys effort on a cold and windy opening day," Thiessen said. "It wasn't pretty at times, but we took advantage of opportunities. We had them on the hook most of the game and found a way to reel them all the way in. It's always good to win on opening day."

With the win, the Little Giants build early momentum as they continue their road stretch, traveling to Norwalk for their next matchup.

The varsity Little Giants traveled to Norwalk and ran into a red-hot Trucker's lineup, falling 9-0. Norwalk came out swinging early and never let up, while Fremont Ross struggled to find rhythm at the plate. Despite the setback, head coach Derek Thiessen remains confident in his group.

Coach Thiessen emphasized that the team will continue to put in the work and stay the course. He noted the importance of relaxing and trusting their abilities as the season progresses, knowing the results will come with time and effort.

Back in Fremont, the junior varsity Little Giants provided plenty of excitement in a dominant 13-1 run-rule victory over the Trucker's.

The bats were alive from the start, with Grady Kelly, Dawson Berndt, and Jasper Endicott each going 2-for-3 at the plate to lead the offensive surge. The highlight of the night came early, when Easton Reineck sent the crowd into a frenzy with a towering grand slam to left field—his first high school home run. In fact, it was one for the history books, marking the first Reineck home run at Fremont Ross Alumni Field. And by all accounts, the ball may still be flying.

Easton is part of a strong baseball family at Fremont Ross, joining his brothers Griffin, a sophomore, and Cade, a senior both of whom are on the varsity squad.

On the mound, Kase Myers delivered a strong outing, pitching four innings of one-run baseball while striking out four. Jarek Mackey closed things out with a shutout inning to secure the win.

While the varsity squad looks to bounce back, the junior varsity team's performance showcased the depth and excitement building within the Fremont Ross baseball program.

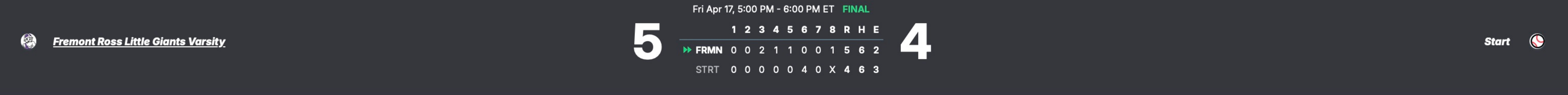

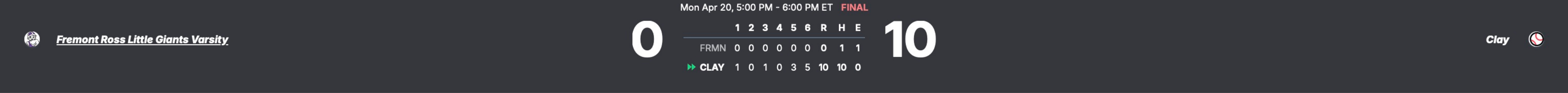

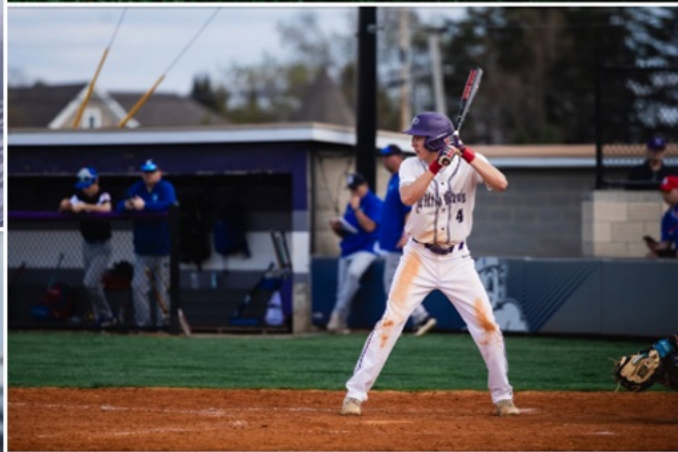

Jedi Mentality Leads Fremont Ross Baseball to No-Hit Victory Over Napoleon

The Fremont Ross baseball team delivered one of its most impressive performances of the season Monday night, shutting out Napoleon High School 1-0 behind a combined no-hitter from Cameron Joseph and Dylan McDonald.

The Little Giants used dominant pitching, timely defense, and just enough offense to secure their 11th win of the season in a tightly contested battle.

Fremont Ross scored the game's only run in the second inning, capitalizing on an opportunity to push across what proved to be the difference in the game. That lone run was all the Little Giants needed as their pitching staff took over from there.

Joseph was outstanding on the mound and earned the win after turning in five dominant innings. He allowed no hits and no runs while striking out 10 batters and walking two. From the start, he controlled the game and consistently kept Napoleon hitters off balance. Joseph also mentioned the stellar defense he had behind him. "My infielders were exceptional, great teammates, same thing goes for my guys out there in the grass tracking down balls and hitting cuts."

One of those infielders is Freshman second baseman Dawson Berndt. He put together a defensive performance that helped preserve the historic outing. Berndt made several exceptional plays up the middle, including a highlight-reel double play where he fielded a ball deep in the middle infield, sprinted to second base for the force out, and fired an off-balance sidearm throw to first to end the inning.

He wasn't done there.

Berndt also charged multiple slow-rolling ground balls and made difficult plays look routine. His most jaw-dropping moment came when he charged a slow roller, scooped the ball cleanly, and—without ever transferring it to his throwing hand—flipped it directly to first baseman JT Myers for the out. It was the kind of play that, if made in Major League Baseball, would have easily landed on ESPN's SportsCenter Top 10 plays of the night.

When Joseph's night ended, McDonald stepped in and delivered under pressure. The left-hander pitched two scoreless innings of relief, allowing no hits while striking out four and walking three.

The biggest moment came in the final inning when McDonald walked the leadoff hitter, and that runner eventually advanced to third base with two outs. With the tying run just 90 feet away, McDonald stayed composed and delivered the game-ending strikeout to preserve the no-hitter and seal the victory.

After the game, McDonald gave an answer that perfectly reflected the team's chemistry and personality.

He said he stayed relaxed by thinking about watching Star Wars: Episode VI – Return of the Jedi and playing video games during his downtime over the past few weeks.

"I channeled my inner Luke Skywalker when he confronted Darth Vader," McDonald said. "I struck out that last batter and defeated the evil empire of the night — the Napoleon Wildcats."

His teammates immediately embraced the moment, chanting "Jedi!" from the dugout after the final out.

Coach Thiessen said the moment was another example of the strong bond this team has built throughout the season, and that chemistry continues to show up in big moments.

At the plate, Fremont Ross managed three hits, with Myles Carroll, Breylen Garza, and McDonald each recording one hit. The Little Giants also came through defensively, turning a double play to help preserve the shutout.
