Saturday: Record-Breakers and Stormy Weather

The weekend started with a historic, record-breaking bang on Saturday. Junior Tierra Parker set the tone for the Lady Little Giants in the shot put. With a massive, school-record throw of 42'1", Parker secured a brilliant second-place finish. The performance tied the highest placement ever by a female athlete in Ross history, matching Shannon Carter's 1988 runner-up finish in the 100 hurdles. Meanwhile, on the track, the prelims belonged to junior Mason Englund. He put the state on absolute notice in the 110-meter hurdles, blazing through the track in 13.62 seconds to set a new Division II state meet record.

While the sprinters were firing on all cylinders, the distance runners had to contend with Mother Nature. Grueling rain delays totaling roughly four hours tested everyone's mental fortitude. Especially the 3200-meter runners who waited out the entire time to show the state what they were made of when they finally got on the track. Fremont's Lily Kiser, in her first trip to the state meet, refused to let the weather slow her down. Running in the 3200-meter event, Kiser broke the 19-year-old school record with a time of 11:04.41, earning her 10th place among the finest distance runners in Ohio. By the end of the day, momentum was sky-high as all three relay squads—the girls' 4x200, boys' 4x200, and boys' 4x100—successfully punched their tickets to Sunday's finals.

Sunday: Chaos, Resilience, and Bronze Medals

If Saturday was about setting records, Sunday was about surviving a war zone.

The highly anticipated 110-meter hurdles final was chaotic from the jump. The race was first disrupted when the state's #2 ranked runner, Barack James, was disqualified for a false start. When the gun finally went off on the restart, Englund, the top-rated hurdler in the state, looked strong until the fifth hurdle. After clipping the hurdle, he completely missed the next one. Showing miraculous athletic recovery, Englund somehow regained his form and crossed the finish line first—only to face the ultimate heartbreak of a disqualification for the missed hurdle.

Disappointment was etched on the talented junior's face, but true to the Giant spirit, Englund didn't fold. He had relays to run.

The Relay Redemption

The Fremont Ross relay teams turned Sunday into a bronze-medal clinic, earning All-Ohio honors for all six boys and girls involved:

- Girls 4x200 Relay: The squad of Ashtyn Marsee, Kamaya Jones, Lexi Nelson, and Braxtyn Jordan absolutely flew, clocking a blistering 1:41.19 to break their own school record and capture a bronze medal.
- Boys 4x200 Relay: Looking for redemption, Englund teamed up with Gabe Wensinger, Stephen Reiter, and Kevin Jones. They secured a 3rd-place podium finish in 1:27.39, a time that now ranks the fourth-fastest in the school's "Top 5" history.

Fond Farewells and Bright Futures

The state meet also marked the end of a stellar high school career for seniors Braxtyn Jordan, Ashtyn Marsee, Ty Brown, Stephen Reiter, Gabe Wensinger and Jace Miller. All six end their careers as All-Ohioans with their relay finishes; Jordan capped off her time as a Giant by placing 13th in the state's individual 200 meters with a swift time of 25.21, moving her into 3rd place in the school's "top 5" history in the event.

While the seniors said goodbye, a few freshmen proved the future is incredibly bright. Besides Kiser, Julia Norris battled hard to place 15th in a loaded Division II 800-meter field. Despite being just a freshman, Norris's performances throughout the year have already etched her name into the school's history.
