Woodmore will defend 'A' state title

Woodmore will have a shot at retaining its state Class A state golf crown after finishing second in the Class A District Tournament at Hawthorne Hills Golf Course in Lima Friday.

The Wildcats fired team total of 331 to finish behind North Baltimore's 312. The top two teams qualified for the state tourney next Friday and Saturday at The Ohio State University in Columbus.

Jason Vie Brooks carded on 80 to lead the Wildcats while Steve Korn turned in an 81. John Schaeffer and Bill Blausey had 85s and Chris Rounds chipped in with an 87.

Guy Paul of Gibsonburg, playing as an individual, failed to qualify, shooting a 96.

North Baltimore was paced by tourney medalist Mark Atkins with a 73.

In the Class AA at Findlay Country

Club, Shelby shot a 317 to win the crown with Huron second at 338. Clyde finished back in the pack with 363.

Shelby's Doug Ingram was the medalist with 75.

Greg Avery's 84 was low for Clyde.

In Class AAA play at Detwiler in Toledo, Ross's Dave Miller carded a 75 but failed to qualify for the state tourney as an individual.

Lima Shawnee shot a torrid 292 to win the tourney and become the only team to qualify for the big school portion of the state tournament. Tim Crockett of Shawnee was the tourney medalist with a 71.
