Travel-weary Aqua Giants ready to return 'home'

Fremont Ross celebrated its 50th year in high school swimming in 1985 and promptly went on a five-year vacation.

It was not a pleasurable hiatus for the Aqua Giants, instead it was more like being exiled from its antiquated home pool at the Fremont Junior High School.

It's been a road trip ever since, but that will end Wednesday when the Aqua Giants come "home," not to the junior high pool with its snug ceiling and sauna-like atmosphere, but to the Sandusky YMCA and a 5

p.m. meet with Tiffin Calvert.

The YMCA is not a permanent home, but at least for the travel-weary tankers, it's a meet in a pool in Fremont.

Tom Thomson, who returns as head coach of the Aqua Giants after a two-year absence, views the five-year vacation as null and void.

"We had the 50th anniversary five years ago," he offered, "and Wednesday at the YMCA, we begin the next 50 at home."

Thomson will put a team in the pool that is short on experience but long on rookies, especially in the boys ranks. Gone from last

year is state diving champion B.J. Blair.

"I'd have to say that is a big loss," Thomson smiled while watching his team put in the yards Monday afternoon.

"Our strength should be in the relays," he said about both the boys and girls squads.

Tri-captains Allyn Spanfeller, Joe Pemberton and Chase Baker along with Kevin Wagner, Ryan Wing and Aaron King lead Thomson's freestyleters.

Returning letterman David Tallman will anchor the butterfly and freestyle sprints.

"The rest of the squad is

mainly sophomores and freshmen," the Ross coach said. "We are deep in rookies but they are good rookies."

On the girls side, Ronelle Mahr, Tracy Baker and Molly Zinkand are the tri-captains.

Senior letterwinner Sheila Poust is the top breaststroker along with Brandi Cooley. Another returning letterwinner, Shannon Vaffis, is currently hampered by an injury.

Heather Mears, another letterwinner, will compete in the stroke (breast and back) events, Thomson said.

Thomson said a strength of

both teams is his assistant coaches: Chris Black and volunteer Brian Koenig — both former Aqua Giants stars; Portia Thomas, diving coach Bob Lozano and strength coach Diane Thomson.

"They have been super," he said.

Thomson's last teams were 6-4-1 (boys) and 4-6 (girls).

After the season opener, the Aqua Giants will still see ample amount of the road — 13 of the 17 meets are away from Fremont — but Willie Nelson's "On the Road Again," may be taking a step toward being a memory.

Aqua Giants sink Calvert in Fremont

It was a time to bask in the comforts of home for coach Tom Thomson and his crew of Ross swimmers.

The Aqua Giants defeated outmanned Tiffin Calvert twice at the Sandusky County YMCA Wednesday, the first time in five years that a Ross swim team has competed in a meet in Fremont.

The Ross boys won 63-22 and the girls 61-25 in the season opener for both teams.

In 1985, the Aqua Giants had been exiled from their former home at the Fremont Junior High School when the pool failed to pass Ohio High School Athletic Association regulations for competition.


Even a pair of disqualifica-

tions at the end of Wednesday's meet could not sour the "Home, sweet home," atmosphere.

The DQs were all part of a too early celebration when Thomson and his assistant coach, Chris Black, were ceremoniously dumped in the pool by members of the Aqua Giants. The problem: Calvert's final swimmer in the 400 freestyle relay team was still in the water finishing his final lap.

"It was a good thing it was not a close meet," Thomson smiled as water rolled off his nose, "then we would have been regretting it ... a lot."

There were no regrets, though, as Chris Schaaf, Joe Pemberton, Tracy Baker, Angie Sprenger

and Sarah Moore were individual double winners for Ross. The five also swam on winning relay teams.

Schaaf won the individual medley and the butterfly; Pemberton and Moore took the 50 and 100 free sprints; Baker won the 200 and 500 distance free events; and Sprenger captured the butterfly and backstroke.

The only victory in the pool for Calvert was by Greg Obringer in the boys 500 free.

"We are really happy," Thomson said. "Our younger swimmers had some nice swims."

Thomson's tankers set a pair of team records in the 200 freestyle relay. The event is new this season, but the one minute, 44.23 seconds for the boys and the 1:53.78 posted by the girls will go down in the record books.

Thomson said the lineup he put in the pool Wednesday is far from being a set lineup.

"We had a couple first-line

people in their specialty events simply because that is what they have been training for," Thomson said. "We had some others moved around because we are working them into new events and we wanted to see how well they would swim.

"This home meet ... home atmosphere — a good crowd," the Ross coach said, "it was a good time."

The "good time" will quickly end Saturday when the Aqua Giants travel to Galion Saturday, the first of 13 road trips.

Ross boys, girls swim past Galion

GALION — The Fremont Ross swim teams climbed to 2-0 with victories over Galion Saturday.

The Aqua Giants boys rolled up a 61-24 edge while the girls dealt the Tigers a 46-39 setback.

The Ross girls had 1-2 finishes in the 200 individual medley and the 200 freestyle, but a 1-3 finish in the 500 put the Tigers away, according to coach Tom Thompson.

Tracy Baker won the 200 free in 2:08.79 with Molly Zinkand second, and Ronelle Mahr was first in 2:39.3 and Heather Mears second in the IM for Ross. Baker also won the 500 free in 5:46.1. Sheila Poust was third in the 500.

Sara Moore won the 50 free (27.27) and the 100 free (1:00.67) for the Aqua Giants and Mears added a first in the breaststroke (1:22.41.).

The other Ross first was in the 4x100 free relay. The team of

Mahr, Moore, Mears and Baker posted a 4:14.4.

The Ross boys had four 1-2 finishes to subdue the Tigers.

Allyn Spanfellner won the 200 free in 2:00.73 with Ryan Wing second; Chris Schaaf was first in the IM in 2:23.31 and Lee Huffman was runner-up; Joe Pemberton took first in the 100 free in 55:35 with Spanfellner second; and Kent Huffman was first in the backstroke in 1:12.2 with David Zinkand second.

Other Ross boys first-place finishes went to Pemberton in the 50 free (25.26), Kevin Wagner in the butterfly (1:07.68) and the medley and free relays. Kent Huffman, Schaaf, Lee Huffman and Pemberton won the medley in 2:11.24 while Wagner, Schaaf, Pemberton and Spanfellner were on the free relay which posted a 3:46.5 clocking.

The Aqua Giants travel to Mansfield Tuesday.

Aqua Giants win double 'at home'

Fremont Ross put a win in the nostalgia column Thursday afternoon, hanging a double high school swim loss on Fostoria.

Ross coach Tom Thomson was happy to remember which column on the scoring sheet to use in the rare home meet at the Fremont Junior High School natatorium.

The Ross boys won 50-36, the Aqua Giants seventh win in eight dual clashes, and the Ross girls won 48-37, raising their record to 6-3.

"My problem," Thomson said, "was remembering to put my lineup on the left-hand side —that's where the home team lineup goes; I'm not used to that."

It was only the second home meet for a Ross swim team in the last six seasons. Earlier this season, Ross hosted Tiffin Calvert in a meet at the Sandusky County YMCA.

"I was the announcer at the last meet here," Thomson said while relaxing in the humid hallway of the junior high natatorium. "That was in 1985."

The junior high pool does not meet regulations for regular home meets but with Fostoria agreeing, enough water was pumped into the antiquated pool to make it acceptable to both teams.

"We had to have three feet of water in the shallow end," Thomson said, "and with custodian Jim Scherrer's help, we did."

Scherrer pumped water into the pool Wednesday night, assuring the proper depth.

With that settled, the Aqua Giants took over.

The Ross boys won 7 events: 6 individual and a relay event.

Kent Huffman was the only double winner for Ross, winning the 50-yard freestyle in 25.68 seconds and coming back for a first place in the backstroke in 1:08.58.

Other Ross firsts went to Kevin Wagner in the 200 free; Joe Pemberton in the 100 free; David Tallman in the butterfly; Allyn Spanfellner in the 500 free; and the 400 freestyle relay team of Wagner, Ryan Vogel, Chase Baker and Tallman.

Tracie Baker and Sarah Moore won two events apiece and swam on two winning relays to pace the Ross girls.

Baker won the 200 and 500 freestyles, winning the latter in 5:39.35. Moore won the 50 and 100 freestyle sprints.

Other Ross girls victories went to Ronelle Mahr in the butterfly; Heather Mears in the breaststroke; the 200 free relay of Moore, Angie Sprenger, Mahr and Baker; and the 400 free relay of Sprenger, Mahr, Moore and Baker.

NAPOLEON — Fremont Ross was dealt a double setback in high school swimming Saturday, losing to the Napoleon boys and girls teams.

Napoleon took the boys meet 107-79 and topped the Aqua Giants girls 114-59.

Both the Ross boys and girls took three first places.

Leslie Hasselbach won the diving event for the Ross girls while Sarah Moore was first in the 100-free sprint.

Ross's 400-freestyle relay team of Moore, Ronelle Mahr, Angie Sprenger and Tracy Baker won that event.

Hasselbach recorded 161.85 points in the diving competition while Moore broke a minute in the 100-free sprint with a 58.58 clocking. The free relay won in 4:10.55.

John Popoca gave Ross a sweep in the meet's diving, winning for the Ross boys with 177.80 points. Matt McCabe was second to his teammate with 146.70.
