Lopez Of Clyde Nips Tom Koebel Of Ross In Cross Country Race

Florencio Lopez of Clyde and Tom Koebel of Fremont Ross ran neck-and-neck to the finish line of the two-mile cross country event between the schools at the Sandusky county Fairgrounds course Thursday with the Clyde senior just edging the Ross sophomore.

Lopez won with a time of 10 minutes, 25 seconds. Koebel had a 10:26 clocking.

Six Clyde runners finished behind Koebel but only four counted in the standings—George Carter (10:42); Murray Miller (10:46);

Mike Shanahan (10:51); Bill Huss (10:57).

Harry Walter was second best for Ross (11:12); then Ken Koebel, Chuck Hufford and Roger Patten.

Tuesday, Bowling Green faces Coach Dick Norman's Ross runners, 4 p. m. at the Fairgrounds. Sandusky is at Clyde Tuesday, 4 p. m. at Green Hills golf course, to battle Coach Art Hendricks' Fliers.

Clyde is 7-0 this season in dual meets and 14-0 over a two-year period. Clyde's victory yesterday was by a 19-36 margin.

Tom Koebel, Ross high sophomore, again was a first place finisher in a cross country meet but the Ross team couldn't keep pace with Bowling Green, the BG runners winning 23-32 over Coach Dick Norman's Giant harriers Tuesday on the Fairgrounds course.

Koebel, who ran a 10:26 earlier this season for the two-mile distance, paced all runners yesterday with 10:28.

Fearnside of BG was second, 10:37; Woods of BG third, 10:40; Harry Walter, Fremont, fourth, 10:58; then Ladd, Yoke and Bogg of BG followed by Ken Koebel, Fremont, 11:21; Roger Patton, Fremont, 11:25; Chuck Hufford, Fremont, 11:28.
