Ross swimmers sweep opener

**Stroempl, O'Connor
Bundschuh each
win three events**

Shouts of encouragement and the odor of chlorine filled the air Wednesday as Fremont Ross swept Tiffin Columbian in a season-opening swim meet at Fremont Middle School.

Ross won the girls meet 72-22, and the Little Giants boys posted a 64-29 triumph over the Tornadoes.

Ross coach Phil Moran was pleased with the meet results.

"We had a good first meet," he said. "We have a lot of first-time

kids. They all did really well."

Adam Bundschuh, a Ross senior, had a hand in three victories for the boys. He won the 100-yard butterfly in one minute, seven seconds and swam on the winning 200 medley relay and the 400 freestyle relay teams.

"I predict we will win," Bundschuh said early in the meet, "but I'm swimming for personal times tonight since it's our first meet."

Brent Tooman and Seth Geib joined Bundschuh on both relay teams. Dan Schrickel was on the 200 medley relay team (1:55.65), and Elliot Hogan contributed on the 400 freestyle team (3:56.44). Hogan won the 200 individual medley in 2:24.43.

Brandon Spicer took the 100

backstroke in 1:09.15. Nate Schrickel claimed the 100 breaststroke in 1:13.36. Greg VanDyne won the 500 freestyle in 6:25.64.

Senior Noelle Stroempl had a great night with first-place victories in the 200 individual medley, 100 freestyle and 200 freestyle relay. In the individual medley, Stroempl swam a 2:36.21. She turned in a time of 1:03.92 in the freestyle.

Fremont sophomore Brittany O'Connor also was involved in three victories. She blew the other swimmers out of the water in

the 100 backstroke event, turning in a time of 1:06.38. Columbian's Janet Black touched the wall in second place more than 14 seconds later.

O'Connor also swam in the winning 200 medley relay team and the winning 400 freestyle relay teams.

"It was good for the first meet," O'Connor said.

Sarah Berger and Meg Nalley joined Stroempl and O'Connor on the 200 freestyle relay team (1:50.85). The 400 freestyle team (4:05.59) consisted of Brittany O'

Connor, Berger, Morgan O'Connor and Kristen VanDyne. Berger claimed the 200 freestyle in 2:13.31.

Sam Glaspy won her event of the 100-yard breaststroke in 1:19.71. Morgan O'Connor won the 500 freestyle in 5:46.02.

"The season is starting off well," she said. "I've been training really hard and I hope to accomplish my goals by the end of the season."

Ross's Erika Parker took the 50 freestyle in 30.23.

For the junior varsity team, Ross's Aaron Gray recorded a time of 29.82 in the 50 freestyle, the best time for a JV swimmer under coach Moran.

The Little Giants will be at the NWOAC Relays in Port Clinton on Saturday.

O'Connor rewrites records as Ross knocks off Eagles

Morgan O'Connor broke two pool records Tuesday as the Fremont Ross girls swim team defeated Colonel Crawford at Fremont Middle School.

O'Connor won the 200-yard freestyle in a record time of two minutes, 24.08 seconds and the 100 butterfly in a record time of 1:04.32.

Joanna West from Colonel Crawford also set a pool record, winning the 200 individual medley in 2:26.49.

The Ross girls, who claimed a 54-40 victory, had several other first-place finishes. Sarah Berger took the

100 freestyle in 59.93, Brittany Bundschuh had the fastest time in the 100 butterfly in 1:05.12. Schrickel placed first in the 100 freestyle in 52.89. Hogan also had a first in the 100 breaststroke with a time of 1:06.32 and the 400 freestyle relay team came in close to a minute ahead of the competition with a time of 3:41.32.

"It is nice to see them swimming fast," Moran said of his swimmers. "We are starting to get ready for a big meet in Columbus."

With the boys 7-2 and the girls 6-3 in dual meets, Moran is looking forward to sectionals in mid-February.

"We work and train all season for that one swim at sectionals that makes or breaks the season," he said. "It's a time for the younger swimmers to get their feet wet and the older swimmers to prove themselves. We're looking strong and definitely on the right track for a strong showing in February."


