

Findlay upends Ross in league

SANDUSKY — The Findlay boys tennis team backed up its dual meet victory over Fremont Ross by taking the Great Lakes League tournament title Friday at Sandusky High School.

The Trojans scored 26 points to second-place Ross's 18, earning the overall league championship.

David Albrechta turned in the top performances.

Each player finished second in the tournament and earned second-team all-league honors.

Brough fell to Findlay's Doug Johnson 6-4, 6-3 in the title match. He defeated Ali Abou-Arab of Oregon Clay 6-1, 6-3 in the opening match.

Albrechta downed Steve Wobster 6-1, 6-0 before falling 6-1, 7-5 to Ben Hannah of Findlay in the final.

Ross's top singles player, Paul Eckert, finished third place in the tournament and made second-team All-GLL. He defeated David Trout of Sandusky 6-0, 6-1 in the first round but lost to Casey Black 6-2, 6-2 in the semifinals. Eckert rebounded to beat Findlay's Chris George 8-3 for third place.

In doubles, the Ross teams of Justin and Christopher Orofino and Drew Wetzell and Brian Gibbs each won one match and lost one match. They did not place.

The Little Giants host Huron on Monday.
