

# Ross no match for Findlay

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FINDLAY — Unable to create scoring opportunities, Fremont Ross's girls soccer team fell to Findlay 6-0 in a sectional semi-final Tuesday.

The Little Giants were out-shot 35-1 as Findlay controlled play.

"You have to recognize that Findlay has a good team," Ross coach Otto Gonzalez said. "These kids did the best that they can and I am proud of them."

Despite the lack of offense, the Little Giants kept it close throughout much of the first half.

Katie Hostler put Findlay on top midway through the half when she stole a Ross pass and scored from the top of the box. The Trojans scored again with just less than 10 minutes remaining as Alyssa Allsop's pass set up Libby Sprague for a goal.

Maricella Hernandez in-

creased the margin to 3-0 with a long shot less than a minute before the half.

"For the first 30 minutes we played very good defensively," Gonzalez said. "We knew Findlay would attack us on offense, and that's what they did."

Allsop scored her second goal on a rebound for a 4-0 advantage in the second half. The Trojans capped the scoring with goals from Sprague and Regan Campbell.

"The second half, we really possessed the ball really well," Findlay coach Cesar Ruiz said. "Through movement we were able to exploit the flanks."

Little Giants goaltender Alexandra Snodgrass finished with 14 saves.

The loss marked the final game for Ross seniors Morgan Bauer, Vanessa Rojas, Alexandra Rojas, Carlea Harper, Tera McDonald, Clarissa Granados and Snodgrass.

"I will miss them next year," Gonzalez said.
