Woodmore wins sectional; Miller, Marvin qualify

Woodmore was the only Fremont area team to qualify for district golf play but a pair of individuals will advance to the next step on the Ohio High School State Golf Tournament.

Doug Schuster shot a three-over par 73 to lead Woodmore to the sectional tournament victory at Green Hills Golf Club in Clyde. Schuster's total led four teammates breaking 80.

Brian Sampson turned in a 75, Rodger Jimison 78 and Steve Burner 79 for the Wildcats for a team total of 305, 20 shots ahead of runnerup Sandusky St. Mary's.

Third, and qualifying for district play, was New London with a 336.

Fremont St. Joe was sixth, Gibsonburg seventh, Old Fort 12 and Bettis-

ville finished 13th in the sectional. Brian Knopp was low for St. Joe with 83.

Woodmore had the best team finish among the 13 Fremont area schools but Ross's Dave Miller and Brett Marvin of Bellevue will be playing in the AAA and AA district tourneys, respectively.

Miller won a sudden death playoff on the third hole to reach the district. The Ross sophomore shot 80 in regulation at Westbrook Country Club in Mansfield before closing out Bob Holz of Port Clinton in the playoff.

As a team, Ross held a one-shot lead at the turn but had problems on the back nine, sliding to ninth in the final standings with 356. Lexington won the sectional with 329, followed by Malabar at 331 and Ashland 333. Port Clinton

was fourth but failed to qualify for district play. Marvin shot an 85 at Mohawk Country Club in Tiffin but his Bellevue team finished will off the pace with a 382.

Perkins won the AA test at Mohawk with 347. Lima Central Catholic was second at 350 and Upper Sandusky third with 356. Lakota was fourth, just one spot out of advancing.

The Raiders were paced by Dan Scherger's 89 while chalking up a 374. Clyde was seventh followed by Margaretta, Bellevue in ninth and Oak Harbor in 10th.

In the AA at Detwiler in Toledo, Eastwood won with a 319 while Perrysburg was second and Lake third. Genoa was fifth in the tourney with Walt King and Pat Dunn turning in 84s.

The Class A district will be at Findlay Country Club, the AA at Hillcrest in Findlay and the AAA at Detwiler. All three will be played next Friday.
