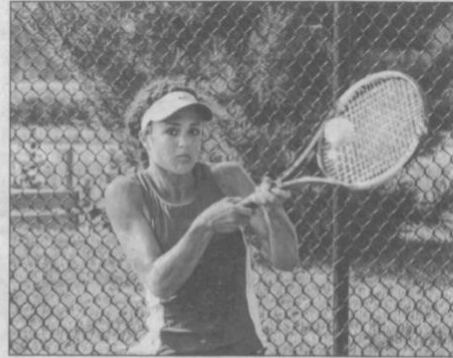
Wallingford defeated Sarah May 6-1, 6-1 to score what ended up being a huge singles point for
