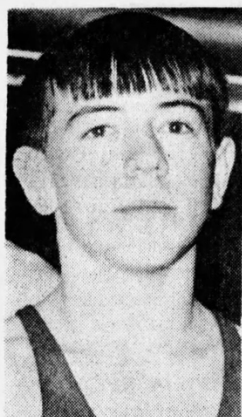
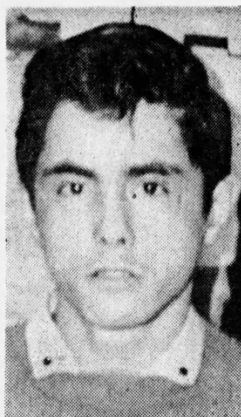


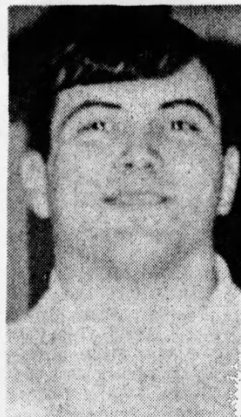

DISTRICT WRESTLING

Five Fremonters Compete

Two hundred and twenty wrestlers representing 65 schools, including three from Ross, two from St. Joseph and 22 who qualified at the Clyde Sectional, will bid for a trip to Columbus Friday and Saturday in the Toledo District wrestling tournament.

The district competition is being held in two sessions each day at Toledo Whitmer high school. The wrestlers will not only be bidding for a team district title, but for 33 berths, three in each weight class, for the state tournament. The state tournament will be held next weekend at St. John's area at Ohio State University in Columbus.

The district wrestling will feature preliminaries at 1 p.m. and second round matches at 7 p.m. Friday. Semifinals will be held Saturday at 1 p.m. with finals in both championship and consolation rounds slated for Saturday at 7 p.m.

Advancing to state will be the two finalists in the championship bracket and the survivor of a consolation bracket.

Headlining the list of local entrants in the district tournament will be Steve Beier, defending district champion at 156 pounds. It is actually the 154-pound class but in Ohio high school wrestling a boy is allowed a pound a month allowance from the start of the season. This has now reached the 156 pound level.

Others from Fremont who won the right to wrestle in district by winning the Clyde Sectionals are 106 - pounder Jose Alejandro, 127 - pounder Randy Sachs and heavyweight Brad Lawrence of Ross; plus Mike

Kingsborough, St. Joseph 106-pounder.

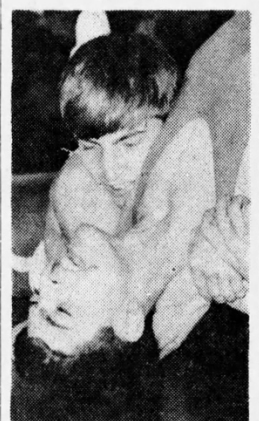
