Rebuilding Campaign

Ross high school golf coach Charlie Baker terms the upcoming campaign "a rebuilding season."

"I know every coach says it," Baker says, "but I don't see how our season can be anything else, especially after the kind of season we had last year."

Ross had one of its best seasons ever when the Little Giants finished with a 12-3 mark in dual meets. But this year's roster lists only one returnee from that squad—Terry Daily.

Those who will be missing when the Little Giants open their season at Sandusky Thursday are John Decker, John Waggoner, John Hepner and Marc Smith.

Tentative starters for the initial match include Daily, Bill Moll, Kit Kindred, Ted Hilt and Roger Hart. Hart is a sophomore, Moll, Kindred and Hilt are juniors and Daily is a senior.

Daily is the only member of the starting five with any experience.

"The other four have played reserve matches but that isn't like playing varsity," Baker said. "There is a big difference."

TIFFIN — Fremont Ross' number one and two golfers were beaten Monday but the third, fourth and fifth entries came through with victories as the Little Giants took a $6\frac{1}{2}$ - $4\frac{1}{2}$ decision from Tiffin Columbian at Seneca Hills golf club.

Winners for the Little Giants were Kit Kindred, Dave Wightman and Ted Hilt. Kindred and Wightman had 47s. Medalist for the meet was Columbian's Bill Mast, who shot a 42. The match was played in a steady downpour from the outset.

Ross won the reserve match, 10-1. Ironically, two Ross reserve team members turned in better scores than anyone on the varsity team. Alan Hepner and Roger Hart shot 45s. Other point winners were Mark Sanders, Dave Maddox and Mike Frater.

The Little Giants will seek their second win of the season Wednesday when they travel to Findlay. Ross plays Clyde Thursday.

Ross High Snaps 8-Year Drought

Fremont Ross golfers defeated Findlay for the first time in at least eight years, 8½-4½, at the country club Tuesday.

The loss was the first of the season for the Trojans, who entered the meet with five consecutive victories. Findlay had beaten the Little Giants, 10-3, earlier this month at Findlay.

Ross (2-4) was paced by Bill Moll and Roger Hart, who scored 3-0 victories. Moll was the day's medalist with an 82. Ted Hilt scored a point for the Little Giants and Kit Kindred added a half point to the team total.

The other Little Giant team point was earned in the total stroke department. Ross linksters had 369 strokes compared to Findlay's 372.

Low man for Findlay was Tom Pfeiffer. He fired an 85.

Ross seeks another win Thursday at the Country Club when it opposes Sandusky Senior. It will be the final match prior to the Buckeye Conference meet at Findlay Monday.
