Tigers, Michigan Collide In NCAA

"We sure team bring out the best in a team," said Michigan Coach Dave Strack.

"Maybe we irritate them."

If the Wolverines, the nation's top-ranked college basketball team, could be for an interesting weekend at Portland, Ore., Friday and Saturday.

Princeton Waiting

For example, the Wolverines first play Princeton and Player of the Year, Tom Gola, Friday. They'll play before Michigan, seeking to live up to its No. 1 rating and nail down the national championship, though it should have been a year ago that the Wolverines have a 23-2 record.

There's UCLA, gunning for a second straight national title and the top-seeded Princeton, seeking to be denied all season. They take a sparkling 26-2 record into the quest for back-to-back championships.

And there's Wichita, with a first-year coach, still gamely coming back from the mid-season loss of All-American Dave Dowd and 6-foot-10 starting center Nate Bowman.

While the Portland team doesn't get started until Friday, the West Coast Invitation Tournament continues with quarter-finals in New York tonight and Tuesday.

St. John of New York plays second-seeded New Mexico and Manhattan takes on eighth-ranked top-seeded Villanova in the New England.

The Tuesday pairings have Detroit vs. NYU and Army vs. Western Kentucky, the four remaining quarter-finalists in the twinbill first-round affair in Madison Square Garden.

NYU advanced with 71-70 upset of top-seed champion Bradley. Army surprised St. Louis 70-68. Western Kentucky edged Fordham 143-126 in the partially filled Toledo center.

Provident Humbed

The Tigers bombed fourth-ranked Providence 105-89 for their 13th straight victory. Bradley had 41 points, picked off 10 rebounds and had nine assists in the Eastern final at College Park.

Wichita, led by Kelly Pete, turned the tables on Oklahoma State and used a deliberate half-court game to win the Midwest final at Manhattan, Kan. 54-46.

Michigan got by fifth-ranked Vanderbilt 75-55 in the Midwest title game at Lexington, Ky., with All-American Russel notching the go-ahead basket with less than two minutes to go. He and Bill Buntin each had 26 points.

UCLA, the No. 2 team in the nation, beat San Francisco 106-83 for the West championship in Provo, Utah. Gail Goodrich breaking a tie with four seconds left, nudged St. Adel.
