

Findlay, St. Ursula capture TRAC championships



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BOWLING GREEN -- Findlay captured the boys title and St. Ursula won the girls crown Wednesday at the Three Rivers Athletic Conference golf tournaments at Stone Ridge Golf Club.

The Trojans -- who totaled 309 to top runner-up St. John's Jesuit by eight strokes -- were led by TRAC player of the year Spencer Shoemaker, who fired a third-place 75, and Jake Schlegel, who shot 77 to tie for fourth individually.

Jack Mancinotti of St. John's carded a 73 to take medal honors, one stroke better than teammate Luke Campbell.

In the girls competition, tourney medalist Kathryn Young paced the first-place Arrows with a 75, and teammate Lizzie Win contributed a fifth-place 84 individually to help St. Ursula to a team total of 338, six shots lower than runner-up Findlay.

TRAC player of the year Erin Scoby placed second individually with an 83.

Factoring in conference matches during the season along with the tournament standings, Findlay won the overall boys title, and St. Ursula took the girls crown.

Joining Shoemaker on the boys All-TRAC first team are Mancinotti and Campbell of St. John's, Eli Stacy and Mason McCool of Findlay, and Hayden Austin of St. Francis de Sales.

Scoby is joined on the All-TRAC first team by Young and Win of St. Ursula, Emi Okada and Taylor Tweed of Findlay, and Paige Kasper of Notre Dame.

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
