### Ross Swimmers Compete At High Level In Bowling Green OHSAA Districts

The girls team continues to trend in the right direction, improving from 24th place with 10 points last year to 18th place with 47.5 points this season. After tapering and focusing on qualifying, the girls delivered multiple PRs and swims within fractions of their best times. Scoring performances came from the 200 Free Relay (Yardley Decker, Elayna Gray, Brenah Parker, Brooklyn Berndt) and the 400 Free Relay (Yardley, Aubrey Pfothenhauer, Layla Mendoza, Brooklyn Berndt). Yardley also scored individually in the 200 Free and 500 Free, earning All-District honors with an 8th-place finish in the 500. Congratulations to seniors Aubrey and Brenah for stepping up all season long. And once again, congratulations to Elayna Gray for her 4th-place All-District finish in diving, earning her trip to the State Championship.

The boys team placed 10th overall with 93 points and saw major time drops across the board. The 200 Medley Relay (LJ Gabel, Logan Garza, Matthew Biddle, Luke Garza) finished 7th, and that same group placed 5th in the 200 Free Relay—just one second shy of a state-qualifying spot. Strong individual swims came from LJ (200 IM/100 Fly), Matthew (200 IM), Logan (50 Free), Luke (500 Free), and Ebon Root, who continued his big drops in the 200 and 500 Free. The 400 Free Relay (Cade Reineck, Ebon Root, Colin Rich, Andrew Tooman) dropped another three seconds in the final event of the day. Congratulations to first-year diver Nolan Smith on his 13th-place finish at Districts.

A special congratulations to Logan Garza, who has been chasing a sub-1:00 100 Breaststroke since his freshman year. He delivered in a big way—finishing 3rd with a 57.51 PR, earning an automatic state qualifying time, and heading to the State Championship seeded 14th. And thank you to our lone senior, Cade Reineck, for returning for a second season and leading by example.

Proud of the way our boys and girls competed and represented Ross at the district level.
