

Ross girls bow out, 2-1

LEXINGTON — The Fremont girls soccer team scored first, but Mansfield Senior had the last laugh at the Division I sectional tournament Monday.

Mansfield's Pam Richard scored two second-half goals to erase a 1-0 Ross lead as the Rams upended the Little Giants 2-1.

"It was a great game," Ross coach Scott McVeigh said. "It was even all the way through.

"Obviously, we would have liked to win that one, and I think we could have. They didn't leave anything on the field. That's how they've been all year. They give everything we ask of them."

Ross's Johanna Wearsch scored the match's first goal on an assist from Shannon Hickey with 26 minutes remaining. But Richard responded a minute later with her first goal, then scored the winner on a penalty kick with 20 minutes left.

Mansfield outshot the Little Giants 16-7. Ross goalkeeper Christina Szymanowski made 11 saves.

The Little Giants finish the season at 13-4.

"Season-wise, I have no complaints," McVeigh said. "I thought going into the season, we could win 10 games. To win 13 is nice."
