GALION — The Red cross country team ended its season here Saturday afternoon.

Competing in the Class AAA sectional, the Little Giant harriers failed to advance anyone to the district competition and as a team, finished 10th with 256 points.

Oliver Zimmerman paced the Little Giant runners with a 32nd place finish in 13:59. Mark Walther was next at 44th with a time of 14:18 and Greg Nossaman took 53rd in 14:46.

Rounding out the finishes for Ross were Jim Butcher, 61st, 15:28 and Don

Goodwin, 66th, 17:14.

Ashland won the meet with 55 followed by Galion with 70 and Sandusky with 94. Vermilion was fourth with 98 and Marion Harding fifth with 104.

Ashland and Galion advance to the district meet.
