Marion Takes B.C. Golf Win

Golf honors on Buckeye Conference Spring Sports Day at Lorain Friday went to Marion Harding, also the winner in track.

Marion had a team total of 350. Second place Sandusky had 362, then Elyria 374, Fremont Ross fourth with 383, Lorain 412 and Findlay 416.

Low medalist was Marion's Jim Gracey, 38-40 for 78 for 18 holes over the Oak Hills Country Club course, Lorain.

Coach Don Kepler's Ross high golfers were led by Orville Sennman, last year's conference medalist, with 45-42 for 87. Jim Kaufman had 51-48 for 99, Gil Martens 47-53 for 100 and Jim Stahl 48-49 for 97.

Other Marion scores — Henry Guthrie 46-48 for 94, Charles Darnell 37-42 for 79 and Martin Altmaier 49-50 for 99.

Elyria's low man was Bill Madden, 40-39 for 79. Sandusky's best was Dick Ohlmacher 38-45 for 85. Findlay's top golfer was Mike Lanning 42-46 for 88. Lorain's best was Frank Csavina 44-41 for 85.

Team trophy went to Marion and medals to the four players.
