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Greg Williamson of Bettsville was another Class A qualifier, leading the Bobcats with an 81. Bettsville's 352 total, however, was not good enough to earn a spot in the regional.

Gibsonburg just missed qualifying for the regional as a team, shooting a 343 to finish fifth as the top four teams earned spots in next week's competition.

In Class AAA competition at Forrest Creason Golf Course at Bowling Green State University, Ross High's Rob Beck finished just one stroke off the pace of

medalist Mike Spencer of Toledo St. John's. Beck qualified for next week's AAA regional play with a fine 76 over the college course.

Led by Beck, the Little Giants finished fourth in the field, missing regional competition as a team by just one spot in the standings. Just three Class AAA teams advanced to the regionals at Apple Valley near Columbus. The Giants had a solid 331 with Tony Bryan shooting 82, Kevin Jacobs recording an 83 and Tom Meade shooting 90. Celina, however, took third place with a 328,

trailing district champion St. John's by eight strokes.

In AA action, John Garcia became Lakota's first-ever regional golf qualifier with a 79 despite the windy conditions at Detwiler. Garcia led Lakota to a fourth place finish in the district, but only three AA teams move on to the regional at Hillcrest Golf Course in Findlay on Friday.

The Raiders had a 357 to trail third place Eastwood by nine strokes. Wauseon won the district with a 322.
