GALION PUTS FREMONT OUT OF TOURNEY

Fremont high was eliminated from the northern Ohio regional tourney at Norwalk Friday afternoon when they were defeated by Galion high, 26 to 12. The Galionites, after feeling out the Taylormen for the initial quarter, opened up and found little difficulty in doubling the score on the locals.

At the close of the first period the score stood 3 to 2 in favor of the Galion crew and at the half, 14 to 6, at which proportion it remained to the close of the contest. Hawk with nine points to his credit, played the stellar game for the Fremonters, being sent in to replace Smith at center at the start of the second period.

Schreck and Zinn, playing forwards for Galion, were the high point getters of their team. Galion met Norwalk Saturday afternoon to determine which team should enter the finals.

The combination used by Taylor in the tournament game, is the result of the shakedown given the team following the Fremont-Clyde game two weeks ago. The game Friday was the initial appearance of the revised team. Their debut, although discouraging, does not eliminate them from the running in the city championship race, the final game of which is to be played March 20.
