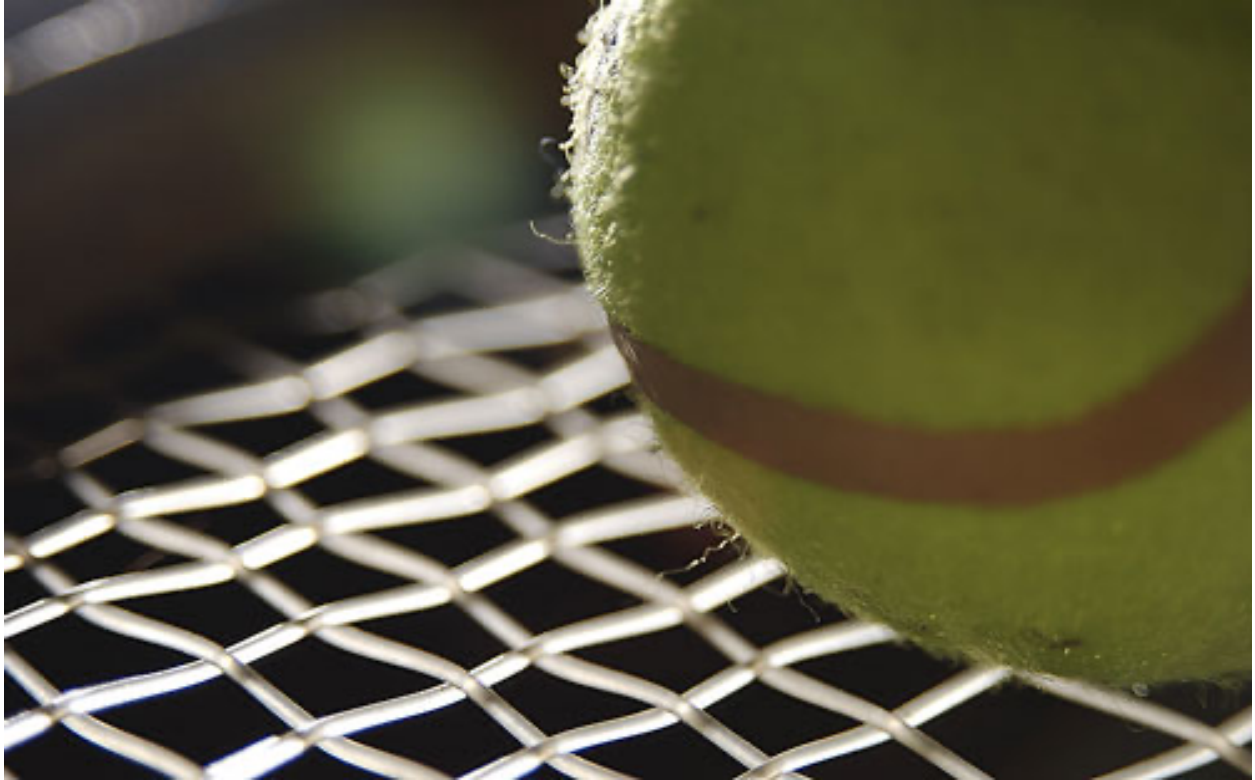
demonstrating their ability to overcome adversity and clinch crucial points for the team.

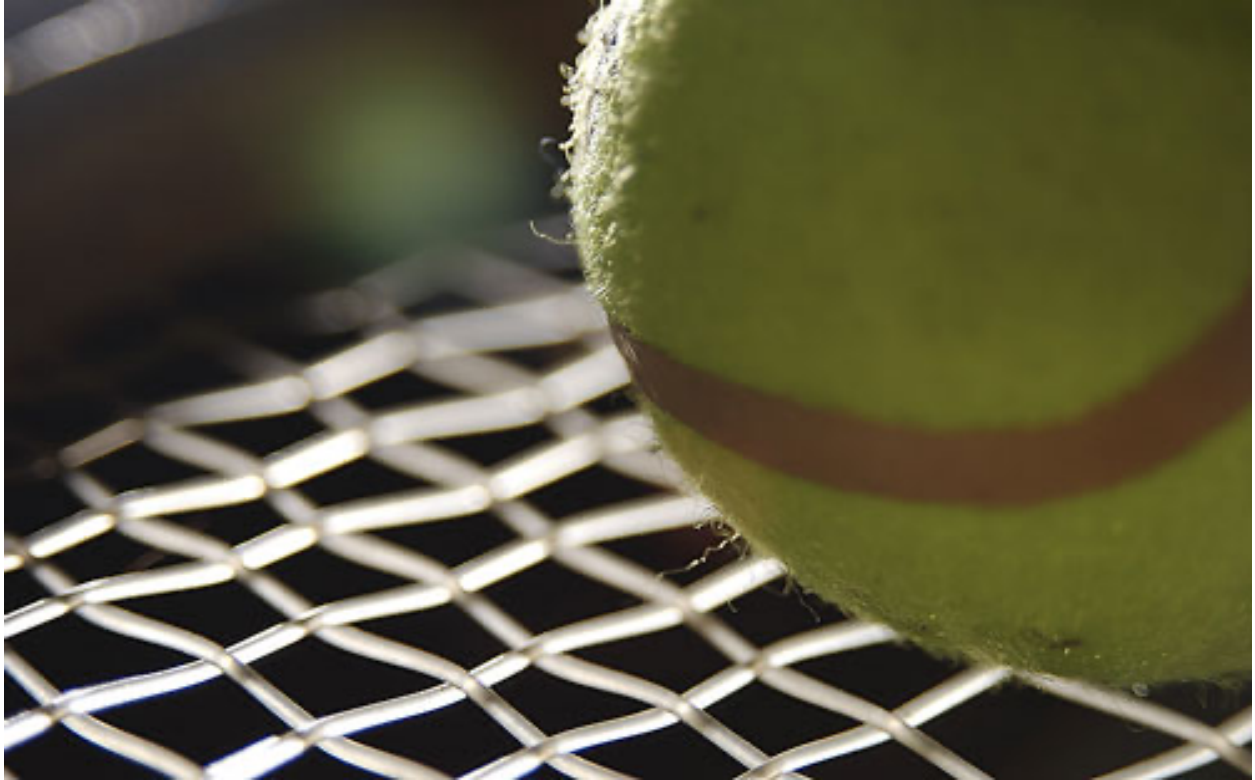
resilience and commitment to the team's success, earning crucial points that propelled Fremont Ross toward victory.
