Brenamen sets Ross discus mark at districts

FOSTORIA — April Brenamen established a new Fremont Ross girls track record in the discus with a third-place heave of 123 feet, 1 inch in Wednesday's Division I Northwest District preliminary meet at Fostoria.

Brenamen was one of four Ross girls to qualify for next week's regional meet.

Marcy Reinholt had a 16-1 in the long jump to place third, while Christy Linder's 15-11 was fourth.

Also, Michele Salas, whose week-old record of 117-0 fell to Brenamen, had a 117-8 to place fourth in the discus. Salas had the 117-0 at last week's Great Lakes League meet.

For the Little Giants boys, Chris Shull had a 53-5 in the shot put to qualify for regionals, while the 4x800 relay team of Ryan Werling, Jon Framstad,

Alridge leads Ross into regional meet

FOSTORIA — Johnny Alridge qualified for next week's regional track meet in four events Friday, leading Fremont Ross to its second straight boys district championship.

The Little Giants girls team tied for second in districts.

The Ross boys claimed three first-place finishes, with the top four in each event qualifying to compete Thursday in Oak Harbor.

Demetrius Simms won the long jump with a leap of 22-1 1/2, and the Little Giants took relay firsts in the 4x100 (Harry Liggins, Alridge, Simms, Kenny Morrisette) and 4x400 (Morrisette, Alridge, Liggins, Rashad Brown).

Also qualifying were Chris Shull (shot put), Morrisette (200), Aldrich (300 hurdles, 110 hurdles), Brown (400), Kurt Snyder (800) and the 4x800 relay team.

In the girls meet, Tanya Elder won the 100 hurdles. Other individual qualifiers included April Brennenman (shot put, discus), Michelle Salas (shot put, discus) and Marcy Reinbolt (long jump).

Reinbolt, Elder, Linder and Sara Thiessen took fourth in the 4x100 relay to qualify.
