Ross finishes eighth in swimming test

AYERSVILLE — The Ross swimmers had many personal bests of the season at the District Swimming Tournament here Saturday. Perennial power Toledo St. Francis

nipped Findlay of the Buckeye Conference by six points for the title. Ross finished eighth with 64 points.

Dave Sanna of Ross broke the school record in

the 100-yard backstroke with a 58.89. The previous record of 59.69 was held by Hal Hawk. Sanna also had a personal best in the 200-yard individual medley with a ninth place finish of

2:13.5.

Other times cited by Ross Coach Art Bucci for personal bests were the medley relay team of Sanna, Dave Stover, Mike Mowry and John Isaac, fifth at 1:47.0; Mowry, seventh in the 200 free at 1:53.3; Isaac, 1:58.7 in the 200 free; Beck, 2:20.0 in the 200 individual medley, and 10th in the 100 breaststroke at 1:08.8; Stover in the 100 breast at 1:07.7; Galen Rhoades in the 100 free at 58.0; Mark Schuster in the 100 free at 1:00.6; Tim

Heslet in the 50 free at 24.1 and 100 free at 53.7; Ty Mitchell in the 100 back at 1:10.3; Isaac 10th in the 500 free at 5:15.0; Mowry, fourth in the 500 free at 5:03.2; Jon Gottron in the 100 fly at 1:11.4; Ed Weiler, 15th in diving out of 48; and Joe Leite, 21st in diving.
