Ross boys third at NWOAC meet

Yost leads Little Giants to their highest finish

OAK HARBOR — The Fremont Ross boys swimming team placed third Saturday, tying its best finish ever at the Northwest Ohio Aquatic Conference Championships at Oak Harbor.

Pryde Yost led the way for the Little Giants, earning a first and second place finish. Ross finished with 283 points, behind only champion Napoleon and runner-up Perkins.

Northview was fourth with 255, followed by Sandusky with 198, Bowling Green (180), St. John's with (175), Shawnee (123.5), Port Clinton (106), Southview (54), Ayersville (34) and Oak Harbor (23).

Swimming

Yost won the 50 freestyle with a 22.60, and was second in the 100 free 50.91 seconds.

Dan Schrickel was fourth in the 100 breaststroke in 1:06.23, Josh Fate was fourth in the 200 I.M. in 2:09.53.

Ross's 200 free and 200 medley relay teams were fourth and the 400 free team was third.

The girls were seventh, led by a record-setting performance by Amy Barnes.

She swam the 500 freestyle race in 5:21.80, breaking a record of 5:21.70 set by Mindy Icker in 1996.

She placed fifth in the race.

Napoleon won the event with 558 points, followed by Notre Dame with 343, Northview (275), Oak Harbor (254), Shawnee (192), Perkins (179), Ross (139), Bowling Green (131), Southview (110), Port Clinton (75), Sandusky (41) and Ayersville (28).

Barnes was also fifth in the 200 freestyle in 2:01.84. Jenny Straight was fifth in the diving competition with 308.75 points.

"The kids are starting to look a lot better," said Ross coach Phil Moran.

"We've backed off the yardage (in practice) and they are starting to respond."
