Ross, St. Joe win sectional golf titles

Ross and Fremont St. Joe won Class AAA and Class A high school sectional golf tournament, respectively, Friday.

The Little Giants beat a field of 13 at the Fremont Country Club while St. Joe also whipped a 13-team field while playing at Green Hills Golf Course in Clyde.

With Dave Stein notching a 79, Ross won the AAA section with a 334, 10 strokes ahead of Lexington, Mansfield Madison, and Toledo Whitmer. All four teams qualified for district play next week at Riverby Country Club.

Medalist honor for the Fremont sectional went to Mike Dopsloff of Whitmer after beating Lexington's Bill Williams in a sudden death playoff. Both finished the regulation 18 holes with 76.

St. Joe shot a 331 to win its sectional by two strokes. Bettsville qualified for the district along with St. Joe, Plymouth, and St. Mary's.

Kim Steffanni of Bettsville was the tourney medalist with a 76. Steve Pfefferle was low for St. Joe with an 80.

Clyde was second in the Class AA sectional at Mohawk in Tiffin. The Fliers, along with winner Lima Bath and Bucyrus will advance to district play. Bath shot a 327, five better than Clyde.

Greg Fields of Bath was the medalist with a 77.

Port Clinton won the Class AA at Detwiler with a 354. Eastwood and Perrysburg also qualified for district play. Mike Gill of Port Clinton was medalist with an 81.

All district play will be Friday, Oct. 17.



Fostoria downs Port Clinton 23-14

FOSTORIA — The Fostoria Redmen rallied for two touchdowns in the fourth quarter and dumped the Port Clinton Redskins 23-14 in a Great Lakes League football game Friday night.

Mark Bockelman scored a pair of fourth quarter TDs as the Fostoria crew came from behind for the win. Bockelman hit the end zone from seven yards out and then from five yards

away in the fourth period. Fostoria pounded out 267 yards on the ground and gained 304 yards in all against the Port Clinton defense.

The victory was the third against three losses for Fostoria. Port Clinton, which had won its last two outings, also is 3-3 for the year. Fostoria, however, has won its only two league starts while Port Clinton is now 2-2 in the loop.
