The Fremont Ross doubles tennis team of Emily and Brigid Heid received the No. 2 seed and a first-round bye in the Class AAA District at the Sylvania Country Club.

Play begins in the tournament Friday at 9:30 a.m. The Heid sisters will play the winner of the match between Notre Dame's Sue Mermer-Jodi Jordan duo and Maumee's Holly Mills-Lori Zuest tandem. That match will begin approximately at noon Friday, according to Ross Coach Pete Michaels.

Should they win that match, the Heids will then compete again on Saturday to try to finish in the top three, which would qualify them for state competition.

The No. 1-seeded team is Kelly Ryan and Ann Harrah of Sylvania Northview.

In case of rain, all matches will be moved indoors to Shadow Valley which is behind St. John's High School in Toledo.
