Ross girls fourth, boys fifth in GLL meet

SYLVANIA — The Fremont Ross girls finished fourth and the boys fifth in the Great Lakes League Cross Country Meets Saturday at Secor Park.

Napoleon won the girls meet and Bedford took the boys title. In the final league standings, the Sylvania Northview girls won the season crown and Bedford also took the boys season title.

The final league standings are figures on two points for winning dual meets and on an 18, 15, 12, 9, 6, 3 points bases for first through seventh in the league meet. The two totals area added together to determine the final league standings.

Northview had 27 points in the final standings for the girls with Napoleon a point behind. Whitmer was third with 22, followed by Ross with 15, Fostoria eight, Bedford seven and Oregon Clay zero.

In the meet, Bedford had 38 and Northview 61. Whitmer had 66, Ross 116, Fostoria 132 and Bedford 134.

Bedford had 30 points in the final boys standings while Oregon Clay had 25. Whitmer was third

with 20 followed by Napoleon with 13, Ross at 12, Northview with six and Fostoria was scoreless.

Grace Durnell led the Ross girls, finishing second behind Napoleon's Amy Vernace. The Napoleon won in 19:41. Durnell finished in 20:05.

"I feel we are a much better team then what happened today," Ross coach Cathy Mallia said.

Ross ran without second runner Sarah Williams, who is out while recovering from mononucleosis.

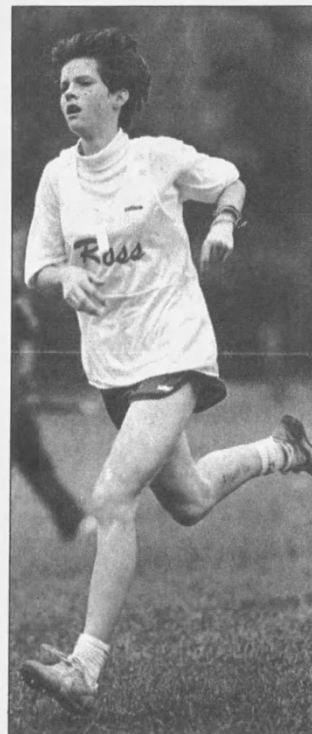
Jeremiah Wagner's 13th place in 17:06 paced the Ross boys.

Bedford had 44 points with Clay at 47, Whitmer 58, Napoleon 106, Ross 124, Northview 163 and Fostoria 186.

Brad Mills of Clay won the individual title in 15:50.

"We did not do as good as we hoped," Ross boys coach John Elder said. "We knew we could not beat Bedford, Clay and Whitmer but we had beaten Napoleon in a dual meet but they beat us today and that puts us fifth in the league; that is not where we wanted to be."

The Ross boys did not have Doug Jibilian, normally their third runner because of flu.
