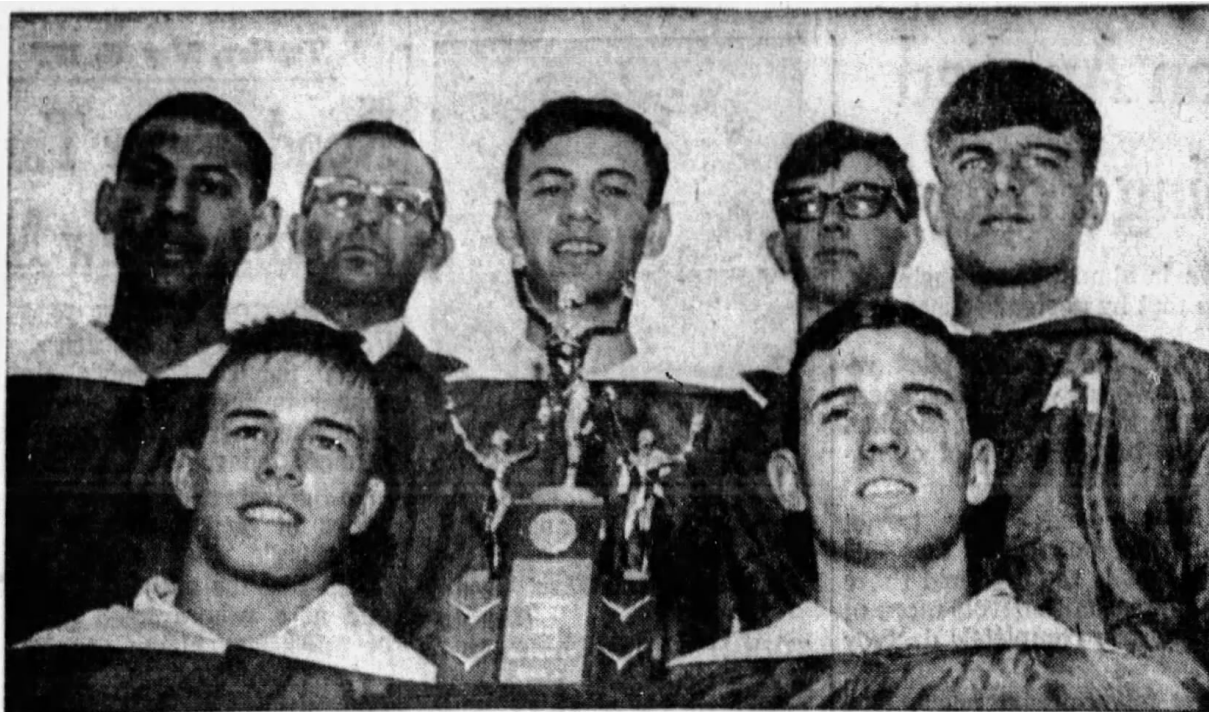


1965 Regional Meet...

Ross Thinclads Fail To Qualify

None of Fremont Ross track men qualified for State Saturday as records fell by the wayside in the Mansfield Malabar regionals.

Coach Rod Lash reported Bill Hoffert dropped his 440-yard run time to :52.7, and beat Mike Holtz of Norwalk, the boy who beat him in the Sandusky district. Hoffert's time still was not fast enough to qualify for the regional meet finals.

Don Roberts missed at 13 feet in the pole vault. A vault of 13-6 was needed to qualify for the state meet.

Ross' mile relay team ran a 3:29 time, compared to a record-setting 3:22.5 run by Cleveland St. Ignatius.

Records for the regional or district meets were broken in all but three events. Two state all-time marks tumbled, mile (4:15.4, Steve Korinchak, Cleveland Rhodes) and half mile (1:54.6, Byron Blodgett, Olmsted Falls).
