

## 2017 NWOAC CHAMPIONSHIPS

## SWIMMING

### NWOAC Championships

Both the boys and the girls Fremont Ross teams won the NWOAC Championships on Saturday. This is the second time in school history that the Little Giants have accomplished this feat.

The boys (447.5) won the NWOAC Championships, led by the 200 yard medley relay team of Tate Williams, Andrew Evans, Dylan Weisenauer and Jared Fox (2nd, 1:40.18), the 200 yard freestyle relay team of Evans, William Taylor, Tate Williams and Weisenauer (2nd, 1:31.49), the 400 yard freestyle relay team of Fox, Mitchell Mullholland, Ethan Taylor and William Taylor (2nd, 3:31.16) and the 200 yard medley relay team of Noah Detrich, Austin Kramer, Ethan Taylor and Mullholland (4th, 1:51.90).

Individual leaders for Fremont Ross were Weisenauer in the 100 yard backstroke (1st, 54.83) and in the 100 yard fly (2nd, 54.19), Evans in the 100 yard breaststroke (1st, 1:00.25) and in the 200 yard IM (2nd, 2:03.73), Williams in the 100 yard backstroke (2nd, 58.58) and in the 100 yard breaststroke (3rd, 1:04.09), Taylor in the 200 yard freestyle (3rd, 1:53.42) and in the 100 yard fly (4th, 56.78), Mullholland in the 500 yard freestyle (3rd, 4:59.46) and in the 100 yard backstroke (5th, 1:02.32), Fox in the 50 yard freestyle (3rd, 23.13), Kramer in the 100 yard breaststroke (4th, 1:08.34) and Michael Dane in one meter diving (5th, 248.90).

Oak Harbor (167) finished fifth led by the 200 yard freestyle relay team of Zach Hess, Caleb Heintz, Thomas Chovanez and Zach Price (4th, 1:39.05) and the 200 yard medley relay team of Hess, Elijah Dombrowsky, Price and Heintz (5th, 1:52.59). Price also finished fourth in the 50 yard freestyle (23.32).

Port Clinton (115) took eighth place led by Jack Kessler in the 50 yard freestyle (2nd, 22.43) and in the 100 yard freestyle (3rd, 51.21), Zach Barr in the 100 yard fly (3rd, 56.70) and in the 200 yard IM (5th, 2:12.78) and Thomas Keville in one meter diving (3rd, 311.05).

The Fremont Ross girls (390) also won, led by the 200 yard medley relay team MaKennah Fitzgerald, AnneMarie Moses, Shelby Level and Katy Kelly (1st, 1:54.90), the 400 yard freestyle relay team of Olivia DeRodes, Rilee Overmyer, Alexis Prenzl and Fitzgerald (1st, 3:49.40) and the 200 yard freestyle relay team of DeRodes, Prenzl, Katy Kelly and Moses (2nd, 1:44.20).

Individual leaders for the Little Giants were DeRodes in the 200 yard freestyle (1st, 2:01.33) and in the 100 yard freestyle (1st, 56.33), Fitzgerald in the 100 yard backstroke (1st, 1:00.54) and in the 500 yard freestyle (3rd, 5:31.32), Prenzl in the 100 yard breaststroke (1st, 1:07.20) and in the 200 yard IM (4th, 2:18.42) and Moses in the 100 yard fly (2nd, 1:02.09) and in the 50 yard freestyle (3rd, 26.34).

Oak Harbor (220) took fifth place, led by the 200 yard freestyle relay team of Abbie Mizelle, Bailey Blunt, Mikenzie Blunt and Taylor Byington (4th, 1:48.30) and the 400 yard freestyle relay team of Mizelle, Erin Druyor, Paige Priesman and Byington (4th, 3:55.95).

Individual leaders for Oak Harbor were Mizelle in the 50 yard freestyle (2nd, 26.18) and in the 100 yard freestyle (3rd, 57.99), Druyor in the 100 yard backstroke (3rd, 1:06.30), Kenzie Pluto in one meter diving (4th, 372.75) and Priesman in the 100 yard breaststroke (5th, 1:15.32).

Port Clinton (172) finished in eighth place, led by the 200 yard freestyle relay team of Bryanna Barr, Brittany Diaz, Gabby Sharkey and Laruen Shaw. Shaw finished fourth in the 50 yard freestyle (26.55) and fifth in the 100 yard freestyle (58.89).
