11 Little Giants advance to districts as Ross earns top seed for Saturday's meet

Alexis Prenzlin won the 200 IM at 2 minutes, 10.72 seconds and 100 breaststroke at 1:03.85 last weekend as 11 Fremont Ross girls swimmers advanced to district.

Prenzlin, Maddie Gallagher, Mara Brown and Faith Zimmerman won the 200 medley relay at 1:49.74 for the Little Giants.

They are the top seed. Prenzlin is the top seed in the 200 IM and 100 breaststroke.

Gallagher was second in the 100 breaststroke at 1:05.38.

Conner Colston was second in the 200 (1:44.78) and 500 (4:48.11) freestyles, and Case Stevenson

was second in the 100 breaststroke (1:03.03) and third in the 200 IM (2:03.36). Colston, Stevenson, Dylan Weisenauer and Braedyn Price were second in the 200 medley relay at 1:41.08, and Weisenauer, Stevenson, Price and Colston were third in the 200 freestyle relay (1:30.96).

Colston is the second-seed for the 200 freestyle. The district meet is Saturday at Bowling Green State University.

McKela Elder, Allison Taylor and Rachel Haitonic advanced in the 200 freestyle, Brown in the 200 IM and 100 butterfly, and Gallagher and Faith Zimmerman in the 50 freestyle. Hayley Wilson and Elder moved on in the 100 freestyle.

Haitonic and Taylor advanced in the 500 freestyle, Zimmerman and Wilson in the 100 backstroke, and Lauren Zimmerman in the 100 breast-

stroke. Gallagher, Brown, Faith Zimmerman and Prenzlin advanced in the 200 freestyle relay, and Elder, Haitonic, Taylor and Wilson in the 400 freestyle relay.

Jadyn Rozzell and Sarah Watson moved on to Tuesday's diving competition. Bo Schoch, Sam Sweeney, Isaias Ortiz and Zach Decker advanced for the boys.

Aidan Zimmerman (200 freestyle), Logan Weisenauer (200 IM/100 butterfly), and James Elder and Price (50 freestyle) moved on for the boys. Dylan Weisenauer and Logan Weisenauer (100 butterfly), Andy Burroughs and Zimmerman (500 freestyle), and Dylan Weisenauer and Cole Dymond (100 backstroke) advanced.

Elder, Ryan Dabrunz, Zach Edmonds and Logan Weisenauer (400 freestyle relay) moved on.
