HURON — The Fremont Ross golf team struggled Tuesday at the Great Lakes League tournament.

Fortunately, almost every other team did too.

The Little Giants shot a 347 at Sawmill Creek but finished second in the tournament and second in the final season standings to Findlay. The Trojans, led by medalist Tyler Riley's 74, won the tournament with a 310 and claimed the league title.

"It turned out OK, but we played awful," Ross head coach Dessie Morehart said. "It is a tough course. We got lucky because everybody else played bad."

Sandusky (352), Napoleon (354), Whitmer (355) and Clay (356) rounded out the team scoring.

To determine the final season standings, each team was awarded two points per regular-season victory and three points for every team it beat in the tournament. Findlay finished with a perfect 25 points, and Ross was second with 18 points.

Philip Foster and Wes Eckhardt led the Little Giants with 85s on Tuesday. Each player made the All-GLL second team. Andrew Aseltine added an 88, and Dave Fausnaugh had an 89 for Ross.

Findlay's Dave Coolidge was selected the GLL Coach of the Year.
