

Lexington ousts Ross girls soccer

LEXINGTON — The Fremont Ross girls soccer team held off Lexington for as long as it could, but the Lady Lex used their speed advantage to pull off a 3-0 victory in the Division I sectional Thursday.

Lexington's Sarah Kudrak scored the first goal with six minutes, two seconds remaining in the first half. Teammates Ameer Thompson and Erin Johnson added scores early in the second half to send Lexington to the sectional final.

Ross (6-10) got just one shot, a second-half try from senior Alison Clark. The Lady Lex (7-2-4) outshot the Little Giants 16-1.

Ross goalkeeper Shannon Hickey managed 13 saves.

Thursday's loss ended the careers of Clark, Natalie Durnwald, Jackie May, Megan Theller, Britini Werling and Ashley Isaacs. The Little Giants finished 6-4 in the Great Lakes League and tied for second with Whitmer.
