

Fremont Ross, Port Clinton, Clyde earn All-State selections

Fremont Ross junior quarterback Kaden Holmes and senior offensive lineman Ethan Green earned first-team all-state recognition in Division II from the Ohio Prep Sportswriters Association.

Holmes program records include touchdown passes in a season (33) and career (70), and 6,029 yards passing. He threw for 2,807 yards, and rushed for 978 yards and 12 scores for a record 3,796 total as a junior.

Green, who will continue his career at Cincinnati, helped Ross generate 34 points per game. He was first team in the Three Rivers Athletic Conference on both sides of the ball.

Little Giants junior receiver Bryson Hammer was named second team All-Ohio. He established single-season program records with 927 yards and 80

receptions, with 10 touchdowns.

He played receiver with a cast on his thumb to finish the season. He was first-team all-conference returning kicks as well.

Senior kicker Johan Silver, junior linebacker Mason Villarreal and senior defensive back Kalijah Alejandro were honorable mention.

Silver kicked two 45-yard field goals and made 7 of 9 tries, including two blocks. He missed two of 48 extra-point kicks and touched back half of 62 kickoffs.

Villarreal had 94 tackles, including 12 for a loss. He added two sacks, two interceptions, broke up two passes and recovered two fumbles.

Alejandro had five interceptions, forced three fumbles and broke up seven passes. He had 40 tackles, including 35 solo.

Division IV

Port Clinton receiver Josh Hurst and defensive back Tyler Webb, both seniors, were first-team. Hurst established single-season program records for yards and touchdown catches (21).

Webb took away top offensive options and allowed defensive coordinator Phil Fought to focus on potentially helping somebody else. He forced and recovered a fumble in a regional final victory over Van Wert, and he intercepted a pass in a regional semifinal win over Perkins.

Clyde senior defensive lineman Blue Norman and linebacker Dillon Overmyer were first-team. Norman established a single-season school record 15½ sacks, with 92 tackles.

Overmyer had 152½ tackles.

Port Clinton junior quarterback Cam Gillum was second-team. Junior offensive lineman Ethan Ranzenberger
