Woodmore wins Class A district golf crown

Woodmore won the Class A District Golf Tournament and will move into the state tourney next Friday and Saturday at the Ohio State Scarlet and Gray Courses.

The Wildcats carded a 331 despite the cold, windy, rainy conditions at the Findlay Country Club.

Steve Burner carved out a 78 and Brian Sampson 82 to pace the Wildcats. Doug Schuster shot 84, Rodger Jimison 87 and Scott Gray 94 to round out the Wildcat delegation.

Finishing second and qualifying for the state tourney was Ottawa Hills with 337. North Baltimore was third

but only the top two teams qualified for the state.

Sandusky St. Mary's was sixth in the chase.

In other district play, Ross's Dave Miller shot an 80 as an individual at Detwiler in Toledo but failed to qualify for the state Class AAA tourney.

Lima Shawnee fought off the cold weather for a team total of 313. Toledo Whitmer had a 318 for second and a berth in the state tourney.

Findlay, the Buckeye Conference champ, finished in a tie for eighth with 335 in the nine-team field.
