ROSS HARRIERS PASS WOODWARD

Running against the Toledo Woodward harriers Saturday, the Little Giant cross-country team hung up its first victory of the current season, 22 to 35, and will meet Toledo Waite, here, at 4:30 p. m. Thursday.

Dallas of Woodward finished first in 11:11, but close behind came Schlea, Druckenmiller, Davisson and Berger, all of Fremont. Woodward accounted for sixth and seventh places, followed by Feighner and Williamson of Fremont. Weiler and Abney placed 13th and 14th.

FREMONT HARRIERS IN LOSS TO WAITE

The Little Giant cross-country team dropped a 30 to 25 decision to the Toledo Waite harriers in a run held here Thursday afternoon.

Steward and Schefer of Toledo, chased each other across the finish line with Berger being the first Fremont runner to finish. His time was 10:30. A Toledo runner was fourth, followed by Davisson, 10:45; Schlea, 10:47 and Druckenmiller, 10:48, all Fremont. Feighner, Fremont, finished ninth in 11:20 with the Little Giants also accounting for all places from 12th to 16th, the finishers being Williams, Keiser, Abney, Weiler and Rock.
