Rockets' girls set marks at NWOAC

DEFIANCE — The Northwest District swim meet is two weeks away, but many of the top teams in the area competed Saturday at the Northwest Ohio Aquatics Conference Championships at Ayersville High School.

Oak Harbor's girls set two NWOAC records and three pool records en route to a third-place finish.

The Rockets had 224 points, finishing third behind Napoleon (361) and Sylvia Northview (250). Fremont Ross took sixth with 84.

"We're real proud of where we are," Oak Harbor coach Bob Van Horn said. "The top four teams in the district meet were definitely there (Saturday), so I have a good feeling coming out of this meet. We were close enough to Northview that we could make it interesting."

Oak Harbor's 200-yard medley relay team of Andrea Lajti, Kelly Van Horn, Lindsay Lange and Melissa Jenkins won their event in 1 minute, 54.08 seconds, breaking the previous pool record of 1:55.65 set by Oak Harbor in 1996.

Kelly Van Horn also won the backstroke in 1:00.05, breaking the meet record of 1:01.48 and the pool record of

1:01.96, and finished second in the butterfly (1:00.50).

Lange won the breaststroke in 1:07.73 to break meet and pool records. The previous meet record of 1:07.88 was set by Lange at last year's event, while the previous pool record was 1:08.87.

Oak Harbor's 200 freestyle relay team of Anna Noggle, Andrea Lajti, Jenkins and Amy Tabbert finished second in 1:47.87.

Molly O'Connor of Ross was second in the 200 free and third in the backstroke. Jenny Schaaf also placed seventh in the 50 free.

Ross' boys took fourth place with 177 points as Pryde Yost took second in the 50 free and third in the 100 free.

The Little Giants' Ryan Newman won the diving event on Friday at Oak Harbor. Teammate Kyle Fisher was third. Ross also got thirds from Josh Fate in the individual medley and backstroke, as well as the 200 freestyle relay team.

Oak Harbor senior Cory Barrett won the 200 freestyle in 1:49.39 and took first in the 500 free in 4:54.68 for the Rockets, who had 36 points to finish 11th.
