

In other sectional play:
Division I at Sandusky

Lexington threw up a stonewall in the semifinal to defeat Fremont^N Ross players.

In the singles, top-seeded Adam Andrews of Ross lost to third-seeded Matt Piper of Lexington 6-7 (7-3), 7-5, 6-2 in the semis. Andrews bounced back to take third place, defeating unseeded Ryan Yeager of Mansfield Senior in straight 6-0 sets.

Andrews will play Tyson May of Elida in his first district tournament match at Bowling Green State University Friday.

T.J. Wolfe and Simon Libsig of Ross, seeded second in the sectional tourney, had to settle for a fourth-place finish.

Jamie Thomas and Alex Rocks of Lexington, seeded fourth, defeated the Ross duo 6-0, 6-4 in the semifinal. In the match for third, the Ross team fell to Joe Chai and Brian Gregg of Ashland 6-4, 6-0.
