## **ROSS HARRIERS FACE WAITE**

The Ross high cross-country team, which has won two matches this week, will face Toledo Waite in a dual meet starting Friday afternoon at 4:30. The course will begin and end on the Harmon field track.

Ross defeated Old Fort, 27 to 28, at Old Fort Tuesday and whipped Findlay, 15 to 50, at Findlay Wednesday. Jerry Larkins won the Findlay meet with the time of 11:36.

A week from Saturday Ross will compete in the district meet at Toledo Ottawa Hills.

## **CROSS-COUNTRY TEAM DEFEATED**

Toledo Waite's cross - country team defeated Ross, 23 to 38, on the Harmon field two-mile course Friday afternoon. Jerry Larkins was the winner with a time of 11:40. However, Waite placed men in seven of the first nine positions to amass their point total.

# Ross *Harriers* Defeat Toledo Catholic, 24-35

Ross high's cross country team defeated Toledo Central Catholic, 24 to 35 on the Harmon field two-mile course Tuesday afternoon. It was the third triumph for the Purple harriers in four meets this season.

Bob Weiher of Central was the first individual across the line, running the distance in 11:26, good time against a strong prevailing wind. George Hennenkrath of Central was third, the only other Toledoan to land among the first seven.

Dick Larkins, second in the race, led Ross with the time of 12:14. Ross will conclude its cross country running for the season Thursday afternoon with a dual meet against Findlay here.
