

Wensinger, Iliff move on

OREGON — Derek Wensinger and Kyle Iliff were the lone Fremont Ross wrestlers to emerge from Saturday's Division I Northwest Ohio wrestling sectional at Oregon Clay High School.

Wensinger and Iliff advance to this weekend's district tournament at Toledo Rogers High School.

"They both had very good tournaments," said Ross coach Grover Dowell, whose team finished eighth with 57 points. Sandusky won the sectional with 175.5 points, Toledo Central Catholic finished second with 153 and

Mansfield Madison was third with 146.

Wensinger won the 125-pound weight class by pinning Brian Bloomfield of Tiffin Columbian in 53 seconds.

"Derek wrestled exceptionally well," Dowell said.

Iliff finished third at 140 pounds, beating Sandusky's David Garrett 3-1 in the consolation match.

"Kyle wrestled really well. He stepped it up and placed third," Dowell said.

Coming close for Ross but just missing were Zac Potridge (103), John Forshtay (189) and Brian Hill (Heavyweight).
