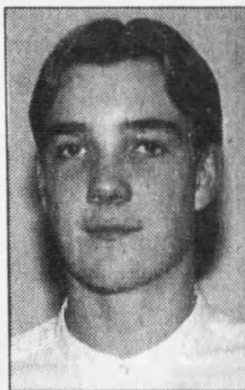

Ross sends four individuals to state

BOWLING GREEN — Fremont Ross will send four individuals and one relay team to this week's State Swimming and Diving Meet in Canton.

Diver Jennifer Newman qualified on Thursday and will be joined by teammates Molly O'Connor, Annie Mears and Mindy Ickes as well as the girls 200-yard freestyle relay team.

Newman, who took second, was the only Ross girl to automatically qualify for the state meet during the Northwest Ohio District Meet Thursday through Saturday at the Student Recreation Center on the Bowling Green State University campus.

Ross coach Phil Moran received word on Sunday that O'Connor, Mears, Ickes and the relay squad all were awarded at-large bids to the state meet. The top two girls and the top three boys placers

received automatic bids.

"I'm amazed we got this many girls to qualify, based on where we finished," Moran said. "Our girls swam the times we needed to swim. I can't believe that seventh place in the 200 freestyle relay in our district is going to state."

The Little Giants' 200 free relay team of O'Connor, Addie Baker, Ickes and Annie Mears took seventh in 1:42.95, breaking its school record of 1:46.50 set this year.

Ross set six team records during the weekend:

The 200 medley relay team of O'Connor, Ickes, Baker and Mears set a record in 1:56.62, breaking the old record of 1:59 set this year.

Ickes set a record in the individual med-

ley, finishing in 2:14.62 to break the old record of 2:18.22 she set at the sectional meet. Ickes also set a mark in the breaststroke (1:08.86) breaking her old record of 1:11.44 at the sectionals.

Mears set a record in the 50 free, 24.93, breaking the old record of 25.24 set by Julie Schaaf in 1985.

O'Connor set a new mark in the 100 free (54.18), erasing the old record of 56.8 set by Sarah Moore in 1991.

Mears and O'Connor received at-large bids in the 50 free, while O'Connor advanced in the 100 free and Ickes in the breaststroke.

"The district meet was so fast this weekend," Moran said. "It's probably the best showing for our district in a long time, if not ever."

Ross has not had an individual girl swimmer qualify for the state meet since

1986.

"What the girls achieved this year is simply amazing," Moran said.

Toledo St. Francis won the boys' title with 464 points, while Sylvania Northview was second with 280. Oak Harbor was sixth with 133 and Ross took 14th with 42.

No Ross boys qualified for the state meet.

In the girls events, Sylvania Northview won with 292 points, followed by Napoleon with 216, Toledo St. Ursula (195) and Oak Harbor (160). Ross was sixth with 144.

Oak Harbor senior Monica Tabbert, nursing a broken arm she suffered Friday night, anchored the Rockets' 200-yard freestyle relay team to a first-place finish and a berth in the state meet.

Tabbert, swimming the anchor leg, com
