

Ross fails to advance

BUCYRUS — Fremont Ross's golf season came to a disappointing end Friday, as the Little Giants placed seventh at the Division I sectional at Bucyrus Country Club.

"It was very disappointing," said Ross coach Denny Ritchie. "The kids practiced so well here (Thursday), and this was just a complete turnaround."

Ashland won the meet with a 304. Lexington was second with a 332. Findlay, Mansfield Madison and Vermilion all shot a 340, but the Trojans won the tie-breaker to take the final trip to the district.

Ross finished with a 359. Senior Jay Farrell shot an 84, and had an opportunity to advance as an individual, but shot a double bogey on the playoff hole and lost by a stroke to Wapakoneta's Zack Allison. John Markman, of Vermilion shot a 78 and Madison's Kyle Swigart shot an 83, to advance as individuals.

Kyle Peck fired an 88, Leon Garza shot a 93 and Doug Garvey shot a 94 for the Little Giants. Matt Bauer could not finish because of a back injury.
