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Lady Giants Make Impressive Tournament Run, Finish Season in District Championship

The Fremont Ross softball team put together an impressive postseason run before seeing its season come to an end in the OHSAA District Championship game at Meserve Field on the campus of Bowling Green State University.

The Lady Giants showed toughness, confidence, and resilience throughout tournament play while representing Fremont Ross with pride against some of the top competition in Northwest Ohio.

Fremont Ross opened district tournament play with a strong all-around performance against St. Ursula Academy, earning an 8-2 victory to advance to the district title game.

The Lady Giants wasted little time taking control, scoring early and never looking back. It was a complete team effort offensively and defensively.

Leading the way in the circle was Brooklyn Berndt, who delivered a dominant performance. Berndt pitched all seven innings, allowing just three hits and one earned run while striking out two.

At the plate, Fremont Ross had several players contribute offensively. Rubi Almaguer went 2-for-4, while Berndt helped her own cause by finishing 2-for-2. Amaiya Gray also had a strong day offensively, going 2-for-3 as the Lady Giants rolled to the six-run victory.

The win sent Fremont Ross into the District Championship against powerhouse Anthony Wayne High School, a team that entered the game with a 24-3 overall record and a 13-1 mark in the Northern Lakes League. Anthony Wayne has established itself as one of the premier softball programs in the state, but the Lady Giants were not intimidated by the challenge.

Fremont Ross battled throughout the game and once again received a strong effort from Berndt in the circle. The sophomore pitcher struck out eight Lady Generals hitters and continued to compete pitch after pitch against one of the area's top lineups.

Early in the game, Almaguer delivered one of the biggest hits of the day when she blasted a triple that likely would have cleared the fence at most high school softball fields. The hit gave the Lady Giants energy and momentum early on, but Fremont Ross was unable to capitalize offensively.

In the end, Anthony Wayne's depth and experience proved too much as the Lady Generals pulled away for a 7-0 victory to capture the district title.

Despite the loss, Coach Rahe said the tournament run was a major accomplishment for the program.

"I am extremely proud of our girls," Rahe said. "They represented Fremont Ross with Little Giant pride in the postseason."

Rahe also praised Berndt's effort throughout the tournament.

"Brooklyn pitched phenomenal on the mound," he added.

The postseason run, combined with the leadership and fight shown throughout the year by the girls, gave Fremont Ross softball plenty to be proud of moving forward. [See less](#)
