Ross, Hendricks meets set for this weekend

Eight boys and girls teams comprise lineup for the 29th Fremont Ross Invitational Track and Field Relays Saturday at the Ross High School track.

Also Saturday, at Clyde, will be the fourth running of the A.W. Hendricks Track and Field Meet.

Along with the host Ross boys and girls teams will be Bowling Green, Cardinal Stritch, Port Clinton, Tiffin Columbian, Marion Harding, Oregon Clay and Toledo Start.

The field events begin at 10 a.m. and the track events at 1 p.m.

There will be three competitors on each field event team.

Tiffin Columbian won both the boys and girls titles in the 1988 Ross meet and in both cases, Ross was second.

In the 1988 Hendricks meet Toledo Central Catholic won both the boys and girls titles with Clyde coming in second.

Along with the host team, boys and girls teams from Gibsonburg, Lake, Old Fort, St. Paul and Woodmore comprise the Hendricks lineup.

The field event finals and the running preliminaries begin at 10 a.m. The running event finals begin at approximately noon.

Ross boys, girls 2nd again

Toledo Start and Tiffin Columbian won team titles in the 29th Fremont Invitational Relays Saturday while Ross finished in a familiar spot.

Start's boys racked up 92 points at the Ross High School track, while the Columbian girls tallied 69. In both cases, Ross was a close second with 88½ and 64 points, respectively.

The Ross teams had finished second in the 1988 meets to Tiffin Columbian. The relays crown was the first for the Start boys, while the Columbian girls won their third title. The Tornadoes first relays crown was in 1984.

Third in the boys meet with 60 points was Bowling Green, while fourth went to Port Clinton with 31½. Columbian and Marion Harding tied for fifth with 30, Oregon Clay was seventh with 25 and Cardinal Stritch was eighth with 14½.

Marion Harding was third in the girls meet with 47 and Oregon Clay took fourth with 40. Start and Stritch tied for fifth with 38, followed by Bowling Green with 37 and Port Clinton with seven.

Two boys records were set, one by Ross and one by Start in the all-relays format.

The Little Giants 400-meter team of T.J. Hall, Charles Chapman, Troy Williamson and Maurice Jones broke the old mark of 44.0 seconds set by Marion Harding in 1983 with a 43.6 clocking.

Start's record was in the high jump with a combined leap of 18-9, beating the old mark set by Columbian in 1987 by seven inches.

Other Ross wins went to 3200 team of Tim Nesbit, Chad Wodrich, Scott Rosenberger and Aaron Potter with an 8:32.8 clocking; the sprint medley team of Hall, Chapman, Williams and John Liggins with a 1:36.9 effort; and the distance medley team of Nesbit, Jeff Draeger, Potter and Phil Missig with an 11:28.6 clocking.

The Ross boys had another first in the boys shot put relay with a 51.6 seconds effort. Instead of passing a baton, the runners had to exchange a shot ball. Chris and Brian Smith, Jason Hull and Draeger comprised the Ross team in the novelty event. The event was not counted in the scoring.

Ross had the only record-breaking performance in the girls meet, winning the distance medley in 13:48.5. The team of Kaylene Bartson, Kim Mathews,

Stacy Pasch and Amy Ritzman formed the team that broke the old mark of 13:49.4 set in the 1987 by Bowling Green.

Other Ross girls firsts were in the 800 relay with the team of DeVonna McDonald, Jada Price, Connie McMorris and Lisa Daniels finishing in 1:51.6; the 3200 squad of Ritzman, Erin Appleby, Bartson and Pasch with a 10:17.9 clocking, just 1.1 seconds off the meet record; and in the long jump with Jackie Weaver, Ritzman and McMorris clearing 46 feet.
